- It is unseen. (16)
- It is intense. (17a)
- It can be frustrating. (17b)
- It can be overcome. (18)
- It is unique to followers of Jesus. (19-21)

The solution is simple!

It involves a cooperative
venture between you and the
Holy Spirit.

Walk by the Spirit. (16)

- Walk (*peripateite*) verb, present, active, imperative: to go about, walk around.
- Your choice or responsibility.

Be led by the Spirit. (18)

- **Be led** (*agesthe*) verb, present, passive, indicative: to move away from a reference point, to leave.
- **God's enabling or sovereignty.**

Live by the Spirit. (25a)

- **Live** (*zōmen*) verb, present, active, indicative: to be alive, to live, life: a picture of a healthy person as opposed to a sick or dead person.
- Your choice or responsibility. (24)
- God's enabling or sovereignty. (22-23)



The Fruit of the Spirit (22-23)

FRUIT (SINGULAR)

First 3

- Relate to how we should think.

Second 3

- Relate to how we should treat others.

Third 3

- Relate to how we should act in general.

Keep in step with the Spirit. (25b)

- Keep in step (*stoichōmen*) verb, present, active, subjunctive: to live in conformity with some presumed standard or set of customs – ‘to live, to behave in accordance with.’
- Your choice or responsibility.



In Review:

A successful Christian life
requires a cooperative venture
between you and God!

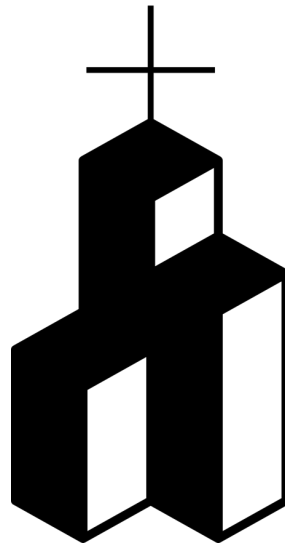

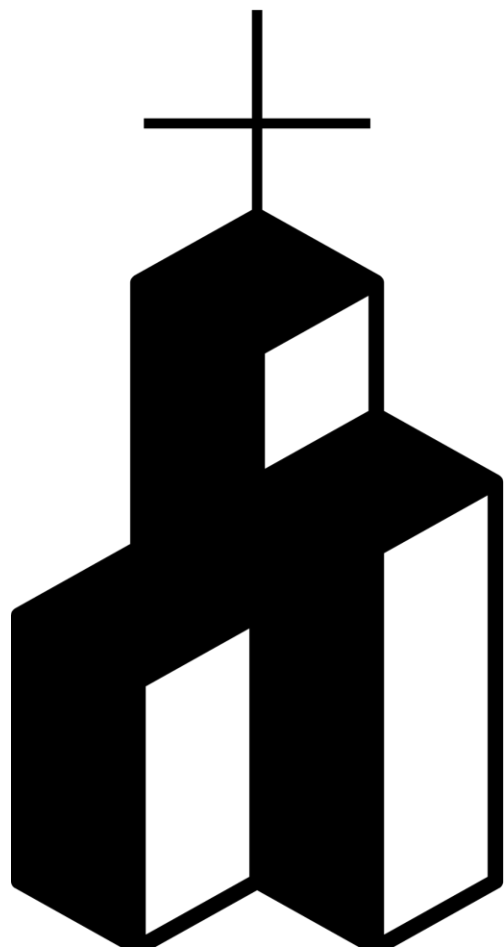

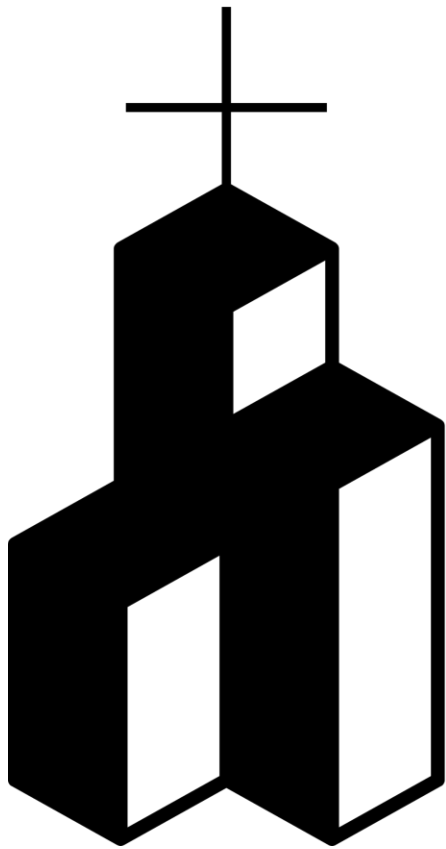
