- True faith is not measured by whether life goes smoothly, but by whether we cling to God in both joy and suffering.

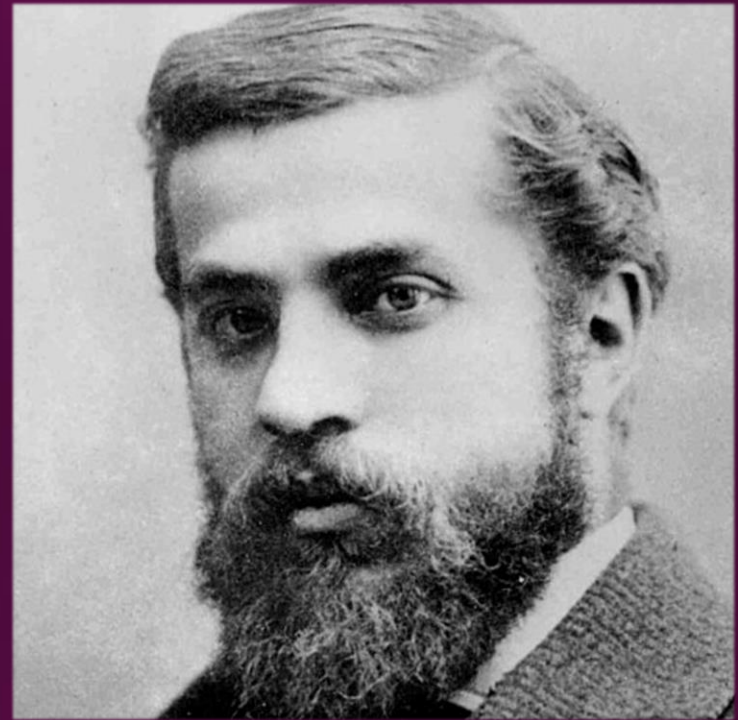
