But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.





To this I hold my hope is only Jesus



When the race is complete still my lips shall repeat





 You don't have to be perfect to receive Jesus as your Savior. You simply must repent of your sins and believe in the **Person** and Work of Jesus Christ.



When you stand before the gates of heaven and God asks you: "Why should I let you in?"



Are you prepared to follow God and grow in Christ, not only in seasons of blessing, but also in times of hardship?


Will you worship God and look to **Christ** even when His promises seem delayed, trusting His plan is greater than yours?






