
Hebrews 12:1-2



"Blessed" is plural in the The Hebrew word **Esher** and literally means, "Oh the blessednesses, or the blessings."

Blessed is the Man

Our theme:

The way of The Blessed Man / Happy Man.

A Lifestyle to avoid and desires to have.

The Blessed Man

The Blessed Man avoids the **Unholy**.

Blessed is the man

Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,

Nor stands in the path of sinners,

Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

A. The Blessed / Happy man "Walks not in the counsel of the UNGODLY". The ungodly man is the first Unholy person to avoid.

"Walks" – in this instance means to live, follow a way of life. How he lives his life.

"Ungodly"- to be <u>unjust</u>; rendering to none his due; withholding from God, society, and himself, what belongs to each.

Ungodly - those who hold godless values and whose moral choices violate the laws of God.

B.Nor stands in the path of sinners. The "sinner is the 2nd unholy person to avoid."Nor stands in the way of Sinners"

The word "sinners" comes from a Hebrew word meaning to miss the mark. It refers to deviating from the standard of God as revealed in His Word.

C. Nor sits in the seat of the scornful. The Scorner is the third Loser / Hoonhock to avoid.

"Scornful" It means "to mock, deride, ridicule, scoff." It refers to one who is actively engaged in putting down the things of God and His Word. But please note that scoffing can occur by declaration of words or by declaration of a way of life (attitude) that scorns the moral absolutes of Scripture and its way of life.

2. Desires to <u>NEED!</u>But his delight is in the law of the LORD,And in His law he meditates day and night.

A. His delight is in the law of the Lord

Blessed Man

"Delight" - chephtso, <u>his will, desire, affection, every motive</u> in his heart, and every moving principle in his soul, are on the side of God and his truth.

"Delight" - the Hebrew word here means pleasure, pleasant, desire. "a feeling of extreme pleasure, satisfaction, or joy."

B. And in His law he meditates day and night.

Meditates is the verb in the original which means "to moan, growl, utter, speak, muse, think, and plan.

"And in His Law He Meditates"

Meditates is the verb in the original Hebrew which literally means "to moan, growl, utter, speak, muse, think, and plan"

Day and Night, Our continual practice. Not our occasional or spasmodic practice! Anytime (every time!) is a good time to meditate on God's Word!

Why is the word of God soooo important??

2 Timothy 3:16,17 (ESV) All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete equipped for every good work.

Hebrews 4:12 (ESV) For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Why is the Word of God so Important?

Joshua 1:8 (ESV) This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

James 1:25 (ESV) But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.

Why is the Word of God so Important?
