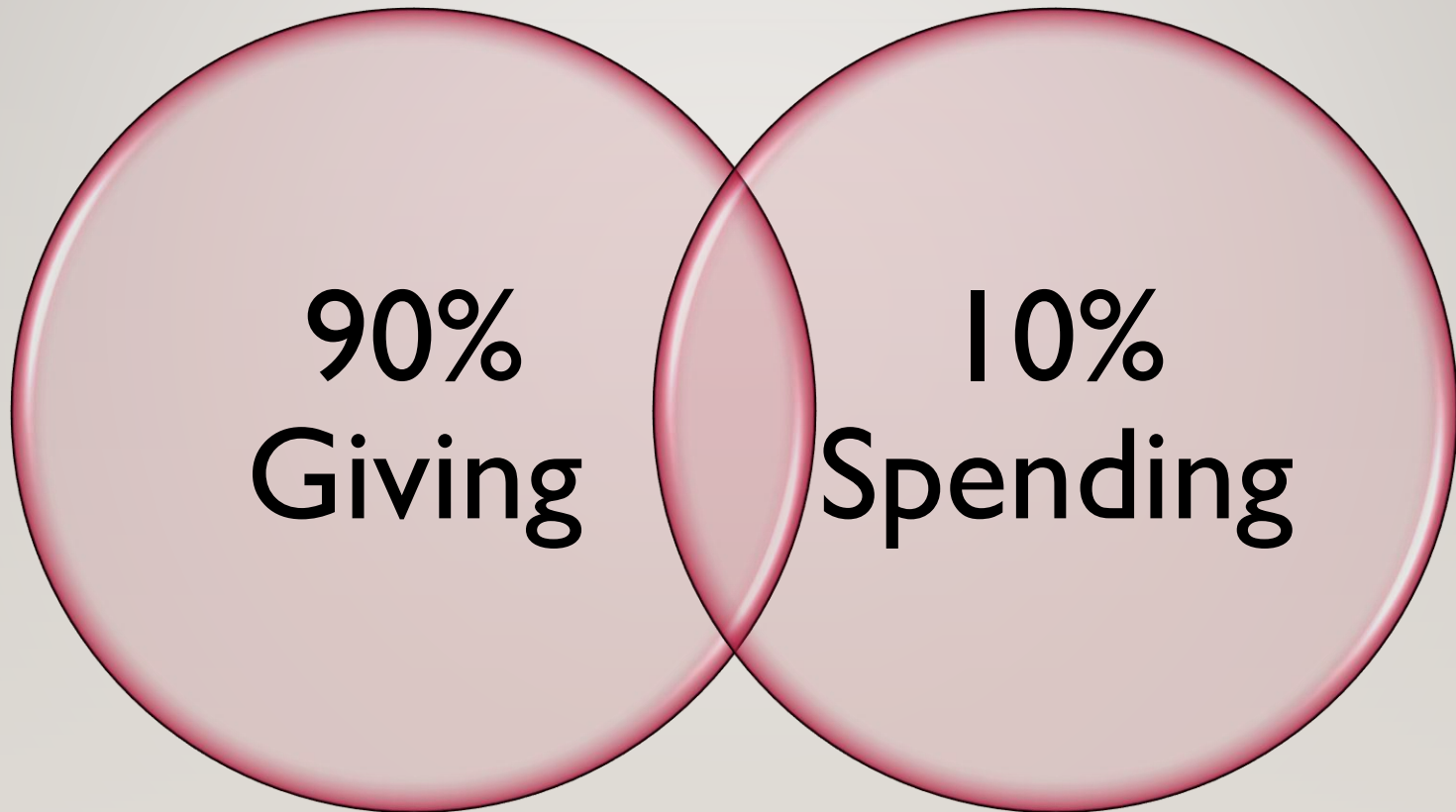
THE 10 - 10 - 80 PRINCIPLE
