ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



## Morning Time

## Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What is one way Jesus has changed your life for the better?" (If kids don't know how to answer, have the grown-up[s] share an age-appropriate answer from their life.)



## Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Who is someone you know who has changed for the better?"



## Bed Time

Pray for each other: "Jesus, thank You for loving us just like we are, but also helping us in the areas of our lives where we can grow."
