

# **GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE**

### GALATIANS

## Part 6: Promise Before Performance (Galatians 3:15-29)

**Theme:** God's promise came before the law and cannot be undone. Through faith in Christ, not our performance, we are adopted as God's children and made co-heirs with Jesus, set free to live in His grace.

#### 🚱 Ice-Breaker

- **1. Fun Start:** If you could walk into any movie two-thirds of the way through, which one would it be, and how would you try to figure out the story?
- **2.** Creative Twist What's a time you joined something late (a class, a team, a book series) and felt completely lost? How did that feel?

#### Reflect (Read Galatians 3:15-29 together)

- **3.** Core Message: In everyday terms, what does it mean that a legal covenant can't be changed, and how does that illustrate God's unchanging promise in Christ? (*Galatians 3:15-18*)
- **4.** Scriptural Insight: How does the image of the Law as a "guardian" or "tutor" help you understand its temporary role in God's plan? (*Galatians 3:23-24*)
- **5.** Challenge of the law: How does realizing that the Law cannot impart life affect the way you approach obedience and spiritual disciplines? (*Galatians 3:21*)
- 6. God's Role: How does knowing you are a co-heir with Jesus change the way you see your value and future? (*Galatians 3:29*)

#### 🖌 Take Action

- **7. Personal Growth:** Think about the four reasons for the Law (restrains evil, diagnoses sin, reveals helplessness, points to Jesus). Which one do you see most clearly in your own life right now? (*Galatians 3:19-24*)
- 8. Practical Steps: Paul says we are "clothed with Christ." What would it look like for you to live this week as someone whose identity is fully in Him? (*Galatians 3:27*)
- **9.** Difficult Focus: What old identities or labels (status, achievements, failures) are hardest for you to let go of in order to fully embrace your identity in Christ? (*Galatians 3:28*)
- **10. Community Impact:** If everyone in your church family truly lived as "one in Christ Jesus," how would that change the way you view and treat each other? (*Galatians 3:28-29*)

Weekly Practice: Reflect on Galatians 3:26-27 every morning this week. Thank God that you are clothed in Christ and ask Him to help you live from that identity.

Group Prayer: Pray that your group, and your whole church, would rest in God's promise, not in performance, and would live as sons and daughters clothed in Christ.
