In the early Church there was a lot of figuring out to do since many people started to become followers of Jesus. Since Jesus' ministry started in the place where the Jewish people lived (Judea), it made sense that a lot of the Jews were among the first to become Christians. But Jesus had told His disciples to go and preach the Gospel to every corner of the world! In the early years of the Church, Greek people also known as Non-Jewish people or Gentiles, were becoming followers of Jesus too. Jewish people were confused on how to react to this because they thought Jesus came only for the Jewish people. They would make Non-Jewish people follow the traditions ands rules of Jewish people in order to be considered a real follower of Jesus. But that was not the case and the apostle Paul made it clear that we are all united because of Jesus. Over time, the message became clearer and clearer that there is no difference between people when you surrender your life to God. You move from competition to collaboration, and you move from rejection to acceptance regardless of a person's skin color, background, social status or past mistakes. We are all brothers and sisters in Christ. We are all United in Christ!
