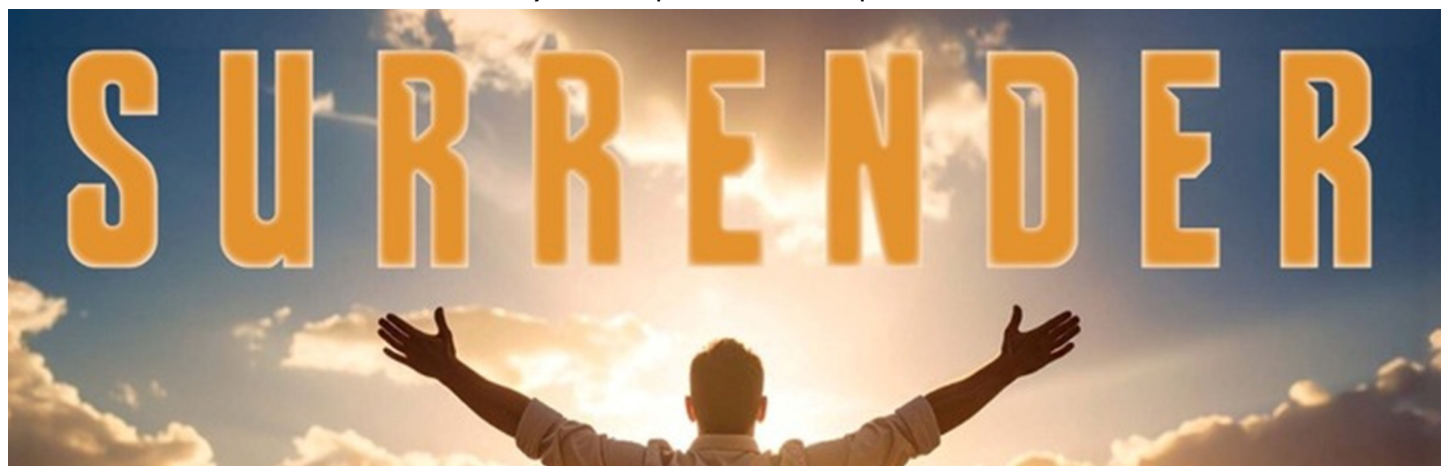

Dinner with Jesus

Have you ever accepted an invitation to someone's home expecting dinner and they expected that you ate before you arrived? I have! A sweet family invited Bonnie and me in, and asked us to sit down. The conversation began and went on and on and on. I started asking, "We're not burning anything in the kitchen are we?" (I was starving). Our hosts offered drinks . . . water!

When they left to prepare the drinks, I whispered to Bonnie, "I don't think they're going to feed us."

She responded quickly, "Shhh."

"But I'm hungry," I whispered back.

She said it again, "Shhh!!!"

They returned with the water, sat down, and the conversation continued. When we left that night, we thanked them for everything . . . water! And we headed straight to McDonalds!

We are going to enter a unique sermon series entitled, "Dinner with Jesus." Throughout the Gospels, numerous stories are shared of Jesus dining with people. In just about every one of them, Jesus reveals a part of who He is, and He also reveals a part of who His host is.

Imagine. Dinner with Jesus. There are several who had that experience. The dinner table is a place for stories, laughter, friendship, family, and honest conversation. 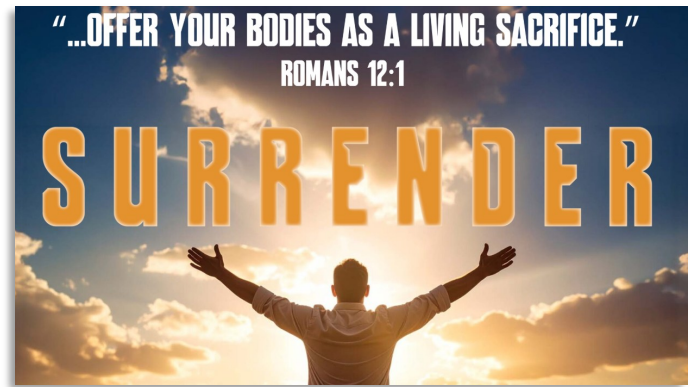

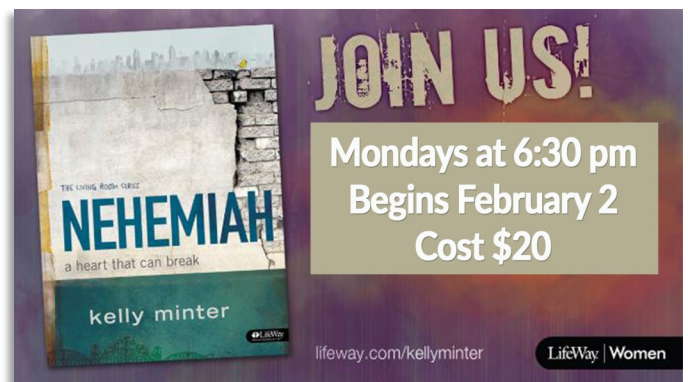


Join us for the Next Steps Experience

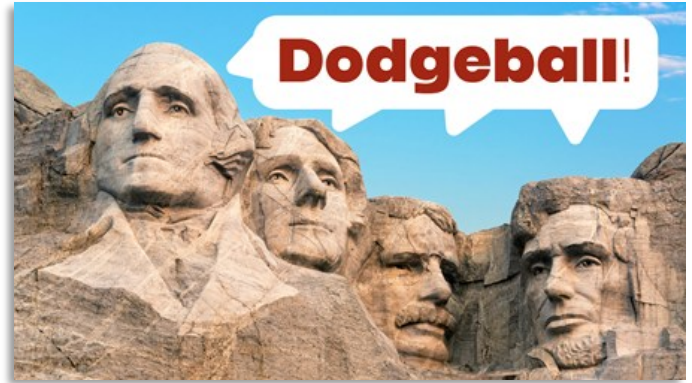

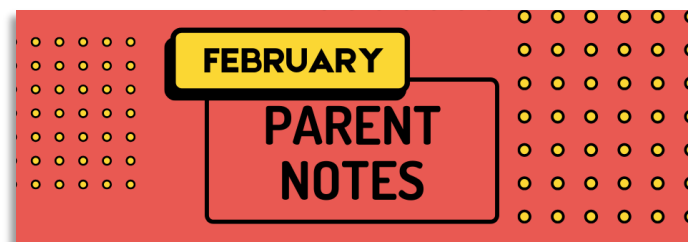

GLOBAL IMPACT



Christ in Youth, more commonly known as CIY, is a premier organization that partners with churches to provide life-changing events for youth. In their over 50 years in existence, CIY has grown from *Move*, their signature summer event for high schoolers, to a host of events for pre-teens through young adults and resources for youth ministers. In addition to events in the U.S., CIY hosts events internationally and sponsors mission trips for high school youth. All their events focus on calling young people to be Kingdom Workers.

Lincoln Christian Church regularly sends students to participate in CIY SuperStart for 5th graders (January 30-31 in Normal, IL) and the high school summer *Move* conference (July 6-11 in Wheaton, IL). Many individuals at Lincoln Christian Church and other congregations point to CIY as a transformative experience in their walk with Christ.

In addition to their signature events, CIY also provides a variety of resources to continue to support students as they become Kingdom Workers. During summer 2025, CIY launched their new Follow Through app which helps connect students who make decisions at a CIY event with mentors and practical steps to continue growing as disciples.

Our church's financial support of CIY helps to support not only our own youth, but youth around the world as they decide to not just follow Christ but to be all in as Kingdom Workers. Your prayer support for CIY leaders and volunteers as they plan and create these amazing events and specifically for youth who attend is crucial to their impact.
