#### After God's Own Heart

We're in our summer sermon study on the life of David and what it means to be a person after God's own heart. David didn't know he was going to become a Bible hero as he lived his life. He didn't know he'd be immortalized in art. He didn't know he would become a cute little children's church song. He didn't know he'd be a Veggie Tales episode. If he did, he might have tried harder. David's life is marked with both successes and failures, highs and lows, good and bad. But in every failure, what made him different from his predecessor was that David knew how to repent.

Repentance is a big church word meaning to make a U-turn. Our lives, our actions, our thoughts, are all moving us away from God. He says "repent." We make a U-turn and return to Him and His ways.

The word repent is abrasive. It's confrontational. It requires us to face our failures. David had to. We all have to.

Our current world hates the word "repent." They hate having to face the reality of a sinful condition. This is why secular society becomes so defensive when their lifestyles are opposed or questioned. They simply do not want to face reality.

Our world hates Jesus because believing in Him requires that we admit that we are sinners. Most people tend to think they are a good person. They think that as long as they live a good life and do good things and stay out of trouble then they are okay. They have a hard time coming to grips with repentance. Yet, it is clearly commanded and demanded.

Jesus said, "Unless you repent, you will all perish." (Luke 13:5) "God commands people everywhere to repent." (Acts 17:30) "Repent, turn to God, so that your sins may be blotted out." (Acts 3:19)

The only person who doesn't want to hear "repent" is the person not willing to face reality. They love their sin more than they love Jesus. They love their sin more that they love God's Word.

David stands out for many reasons, not for perfection (far from it), but for showing us how to return to God again.


#### **Church-Wide Prayer Opportunity**

#### **LOCAL IMPACT**

Inner City Mission

is a ministry in Springfield, IL, that helps the homeless



find their way Home by giving what is needed to bring about lasting joy, peace, and stability in their lives. Shelter, sustenance, clothing, teaching, and Christian mentorship are all elements of the stable environment we provide to children, their parents, and single adults in order to expand joy and peace in each person's heart, family, friendships, and community.

We believe that the root cause of homelessness is not the lack of a house, job, or material resources, but actually the absent, broken, lost, or rejected relational resources that often exist in a person's life. For this reason, we implement a 3-pronged relational approach called *Stability for Life*.

The first stage is *Calming the Chaos* in which we provide a stable environment where the root cause of chaos in the individual's life can be understood and addressed together. Once the chaos has calmed, the second stage, *Promoting the Potential*, begins as we encourage holistic growth in each person, discussing their strengths and weaknesses as they pursue spiritual, emotional, and relational stability. The final stage is *Realizing the Reward*, during which we both come alongside individuals as they process what stability looks like in various areas of their lives, as well as discuss and exemplify how Jesus's love is the foundation for truly lasting stability.

We have 20 bedrooms for individuals and families, and we provide a home to an average of 33 people each night!


