Learning Contentment

The last time I flew, the flight attendants started passing out refreshments; that's all pretty normal. My flight was very early and I skipped breakfast so I was a little hungry. Happy to see the snack cart, I was offered a tiny glass of soda and the tiniest package of airline peanuts. "Sure. Thank you." But the dude next to me had the gall to ask if he could have two bags of peanuts. Wait a minute, that can't be allowed, can it? But sure enough, the flight attendant gave him two bags. There I sat with my seven peanuts (L.O.L.), but somehow this guy had 14. I found myself displeased.

The last of the Ten Commandments is interesting. The Tenth Commandment says, "You shall not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor." Not his shelter ... not his wife ... not his servants or ox or donkey. (In other words, not his house, relationships, friends, job, transportation, or peanuts.) Oops!

The antidote to coveting is contentment. Paul says, "I've learned the secret of being content no matter what my circumstances." Learned? Yes! Contentment is something you have to learn. It does not come naturally. I am not by nature a contented person, and neither are you. It is not automatic. You have to learn to be content.

We spend so much of our time chasing things that never satisfy us in the end. According to many in the Bible, there is a powerful unleashing that happens to the person who finds contentment.

Contentment brings us deep abiding joy instead of fleeting happiness. The tragedy is, many never experience this joy.

Paul also wrote, "Godliness with contentment is great gain" (I Timothy 6:6). Great gain? I want great gain! Don't we all?

Our next sermon series will take us on a journey to discover this thing called, "contentment." I'm very excited, because if this is a life changing matter, and scripture says it is, then it's definitely something we all want to learn.

Need a Fresh Start on Your Bible Reading?





GLOBAL IMPACT-

Kerala Christian Evangelistic Mission




In 1970 with an invitation from Leon Appel, the President of Lincoln Christian College and Seminary, Mathew and Rachel Varughese came to Lincoln. They had come to the US seeking the American

dream, but because of the encouragement and persistence of President Appel and many others who had a dream of sending immigrant students armed with the gospel to their closed countries, Mathew made a life changing commitment to the Kingdom. He went back to India in 1974 and established Kerala Christian Evangelistic Mission. The mission moved to the predominately Muslim area of the state of Kerala to share the Good News with Hindus and Muslims.

Over many years Mathew and his team, with God's blessing, have been able to establish 26 New Testament churches. These churches are fully independent in leadership and finances. They are 175-320 in size and 70% of these believers were from Hindu/Muslim backgrounds. A few years ago, KCEM went through a leadership transition. God

brought James and Valsa Abraham to continue the growth of the mission. James' skill in dealing with government agencies and paperwork is exceptional. He developed, expanded, and strengthened leadership, the



church grew their ministries, and the impact they are making in difficult environments is nothing short of miraculous. He has invited all of the churches to give a portion of their offering to a general mission fund that is designated to supplement income from the US for the new church plants that are in progress.

Four years ago, KCEM identified areas that had no New Testament churches. They picked a tribal area that was around five hours away from their headquarters and is in a neighboring state. Over the last few years they have established new church plants. Since they are in a brand new area with a brand new language they are diligently monitoring their growth and their needs. Most people are poorly educated and irreligious. Pray for this effort. The state government recently passed an anti-conversion law and their team is navigating this. We are thrilled that Felix, son of Rachel and

Mathew, and liaison between the US supporting churches and KCEM, will be with us on Sunday, Oc-



tober 22, to share more about this exciting work!
