The End!

I agreed to meet my family for lunch. Son, daughter and grandkids, Grandma Bonbon and Papa. When my children asked what time, I said "11:45 and the last one there has to pay." When Bonnie asked the kids what time we were meeting, they told her noon. My kids are hilarious. Bonnie showed up late and unprepared to pay.

Have you ever forgotten your wallet and didn't discover it until the restaurant bill came? You reached for it and suddenly had the empty feeling that you were unable to pay your bill. A man in front of me just this past week couldn't get his debit card to work. He was unable to pay. You could see the anxiety in his face, the emptiness of not knowing what was happening, and the questions that filled his mind. He was forced to step out of line and call his wife to see what he was doing wrong. You could see the embarrassment. You could feel the tension.

That's what the end times will be like for many when Jesus returns. Unbelievers will have the immediate empty feeling of knowing they wasted a life and now have a bill that they're not equipped to pay.

Unbelieving people in ancient times mocked the idea of a coming Messiah. Unbelieving people of our day mock the idea of a second coming of Jesus.

We were told there would be mockers at the end: "Above all, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires." (II Peter 3:3)

Got questions about the end of days? It's tempting to debate. Even though some ideas are filled with landmines, and Scriptures can be confusing, we can find some basic information and instructions.

Following Easter, we will dive into end time teachings and what it all means for us. Our April series is titled "The End: What Happens Next?" This series will help unpack simple guidelines to end time understanding.

I'd bet many of your friends could benefit from a short series like this. If you've been meaning to invite someone, this could open the door you were hoping for. Try it. Let's see what God does with it.


Newcomers Reception



HeartSong, our jr. high choir, will be on our annual ministry tour April 19-21, 2024.

The 2024 message of HeartSong is entitled "Sticky Notes and Bible Quotes." Through a collection of worship songs, brief drama sketches, and scripture, HeartSong's message is relevant for all ages that will encourage and uplift you. The songs are great arrangements from such Christian recording artists as Cody Carnes, TobyMac, Maverick City Music, and Pat Barrett. The concert is approximately 35 minutes in length.

HeartSong consists of 33 students – 5th thru 8th grades, which includes Choir, T.R.A.S.H., (a percussion ensemble which creates unique and amazing rhythms using found objects made of plastic and metal sort of like STOMP), and Drama Team. With sponsors, the total group will be 44.

GLOBAL IMPACT

P.B.T. was founded in 1976 to mobilize churches to send

missionaries who would use Bible translation for church planting and growth. The PBT team consists of over 600 workers who serve in 30 different countries. Our church joyfully supports two families

who serve on the PBT staff:





Joanna & Jan Barczuk (pronounced Yon BARchuck).

LCC has partnered with the Smiths in Bible translation work for almost 40 years. Last fall, Rondal and Janice sold their house and moved to an assisted living apartment. Despite multiple hospital stays and health concerns for Janice, Rondal continues his ministry at PBT. Please pray for them as they tackle new challenges that lie ahead. They are a true testimony of Kingdom service!

Jan Barczuk lives in Illinois, but serves as the Poland Partner Coordinator and is involved in ministry to the Roma people and also with a project to translate the Bible into the Action Bible Sign Language in Polish Sign Language for the deaf. In the past five months, Jan has been able to lead 5 humanitarian trips into Ukraine to share food, clothing, and medicine.

Praise God for His faithfulness to see Bible translation projects come to completion so that many people will be able to read God's word in their native language. Please keep the Smiths, Barczuks, and PBT workers in your prayers. Ask God to give them wisdom and favor in translation work, and to bless and provide what is needed to finish translation projects. There are over 1,400 languages and over 200 sign languages that still need translation projects to begin. Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest field." (Matthew 9:37-38)
