Support Our Missionaries

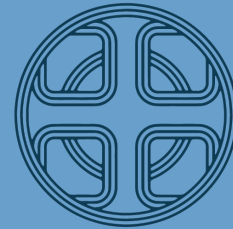

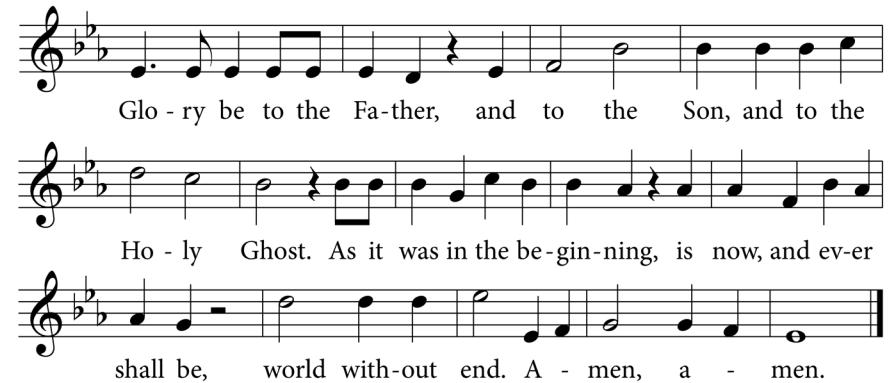
