## Safety Training

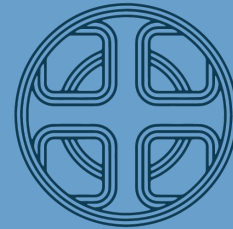

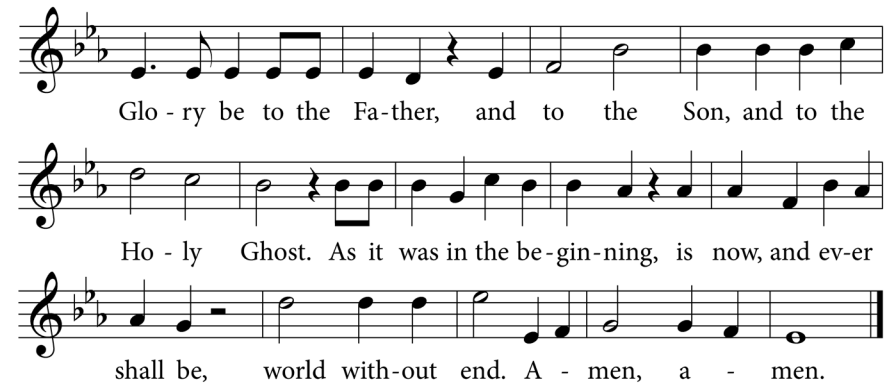
