January has been an exciting and busy time for handbells! Earlier this month, I had the opportunity to attend Handbell Musicians of America's "College" Ring-In in central Pennsylvania. This annual event is for young adult ringers under 30 to connect with each other while preparing a full concert in only three days! This is an event I have wanted to attend since its inception in 2016, and I'm very glad to have finally made it this year. Mid-January saw the start of a six-week beginning handbell class. We have 11 new ringers of all ages learning how to play bells and read music—and doing amazing! I'm very proud of all their hard work and the progress they've made in only two weeks.

Finally, Livermore has a new ecumenical handbell choir: "Vine and Branches" brings together ringers from three Livermore churches: Asbury UMC, First Presbyterian Church, and Our Savior Lutheran Ministries. This conference is expected to draw ringers from across California, Nevada, and Hawaii. We are excited to have the opportunity to ring with musicians from other local churches and represent Livermore at this event!
