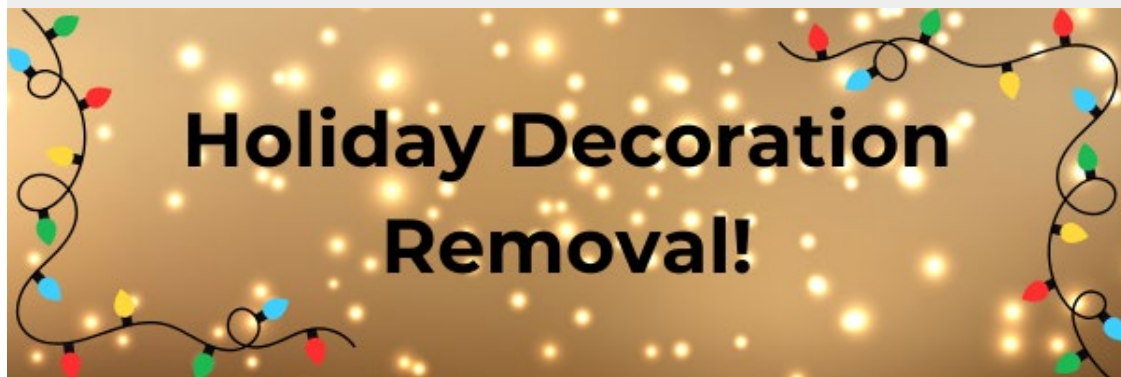

RSVP to Scott Smith or the church office so we know how many potatoes to bake 😊

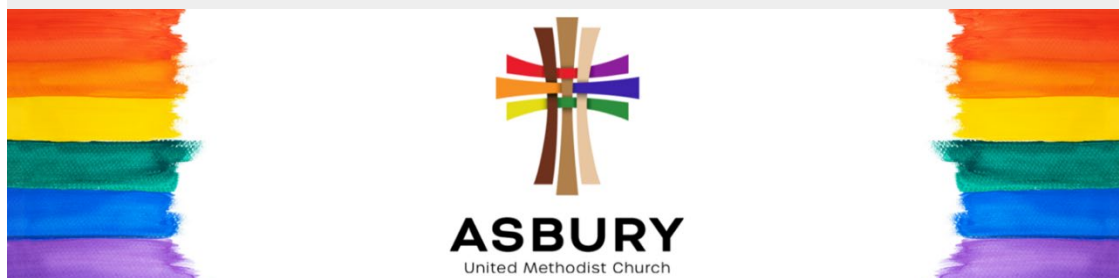

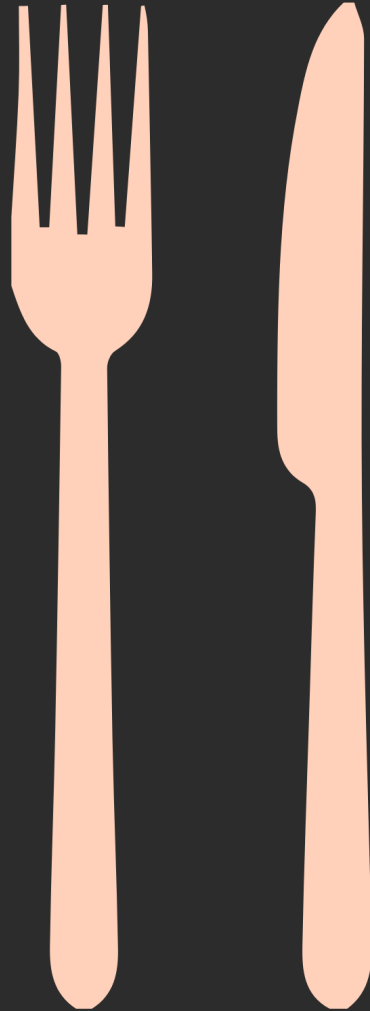

Asbury has been asked by our District Superintendent, Samuel Wong, to host a District meeting regarding the current situation facing Palestinians in Gaza and the West Bank. Everyone at Asbury is invited to attend. The Friends of Wadi

Since the United Nations' approval of President Trump's controversial 20-point peace plan for Gaza, Palestinians have continued to be killed there, while the West Bank experiences a slow, silent takeover of land.

Although the administration has publicly criticized Israel for plans to annex Palestinian land in the West Bank, de facto annexation takes place on a daily basis. This event will provide an opportunity to hear about the Palestinian reality on the ground and explore ways we can engage in faithful actions for an equitable peace in the Middle East.
