What's with the "Private Property" signs on the doors?

Asbury's Board of Trustees contacted the board of the United Methodist Church California-Nevada Conference for guidance on how to handle potential Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) actions on campus. The private property notices were posted a result of the guidance we received from the conference.

Under federal law, ICE agents may freely enter public spaces but may not enter private spaces freely. A valid judicial search warrant is required to enter private property.

We at Asbury have decided to designate our regularly used meeting rooms as

private spaces. We have also posted a copy of the Conference Guidance in or near these meeting spaces (Fellowship Hall, Chapel building and classrooms, meeting rooms 10-15) and in the office.

In essence, the guidance is as follows:

- ·Refer agents to the point person (an Asbury Staff member) who is on campus
- •The point person should ask for identification and badges, to make sure they are dealing with ICE agents
- •The point person should determine what ICE wants, including verifying they have a judicial warrant.
- ·If they do not have a judicial warrant (a sample is in the documentation posted around campus), then they should be told that they are here without any legal authority and Asbury does not consent to any searches or entry.
- •Do not impede or interfere with them. If you feel comfortable doing so, video the entire encounter.
