


Food Is Needed



# Asbury's financial status still good

Giving in October was down a bit at \$36.7K and expenses somewhat higher than normal at \$61.9K. The higher expenses were due to donations to other non-profits from our budget, cost sharing the youth director from Lynnewood UMC, and a three-payroll month (since we pay bi-weekly this happens every six months). As can be seen by the data below, we are still positive for the year. **Keep those pledges coming in!**

# Eat me – drink me – would you??

After an event in Fellowship Hall, we often find food left out, either on tables in the hall or in the kitchen. Sometimes there is a note attached reading "help yourself" but often there is not. People assume that "somebody" will eat it; after all, they know where it came from, what it was purchased or made for, and how fresh it is. But anyone else coming into the kitchen knows none of these things. Ask yourself, would you eat food left lying around that you know nothing about?

Please do not leave food in the kitchen because "somebody" will use it. All food left in the kitchen should be labelled with the date it was left, who left it, and what event it is for. There are labels and tape in the drawer by the handwashing sink just for this purpose. If you do have leftovers that you plan to leave for another group to use, please make sure you have contacted that group, they know the food is there, and it is labelled!

As a follow on, the refrigerator and freezer will be cleaned out the week of Dec 22. All food past its expiration will be tossed. Any food that is not commonly used for Asbury events (salad dressings, condiments, syrup) will also be tossed unless it has an owner's name on it.

# **Shower Trailer**

The mission of this trailer is for both SSP (Sierra Service Project) and UMVIM (United Methodist Volunteers in Mission) to have hot showers available at the end of a hard days work. It will parked at the sponsoring church. The volunteer work may be rebuilding flooded homes, building a replacement home after a fire, removing an invasive species, or many other projects.

The shower trailer will contain 6 shower/dressing rooms (including a larger limited mobility shower/dressing room), two hot water heaters, low voltage lighting, forced ventilation, and a clothes washer. All the dressing rooms have robe hooks, towel racks, a bench as well as LED lighting, and an "occupied /vacant" sign lock system on each door.

So you might ask . . . Can I help build this thing?? Yes You Can!

There will be sign-ups posted in the office and on the shower trailer. Most of the work will be starting in late November.

And . . . Donations toward the completion and ongoing expenses, may be made to Asbury UMC with a note "Shower Trailer" or account 3110.


