Financial Report for January

January is an unusual financial month for Asbury. There is a significant amount of prepaid pledges recorded near the end of the previous year. Last year we received \$75,820 in prepaid pledges. Of this amount, \$33,110 was set aside to pay our insurance bill next December. The rest, \$42,710, shows as income for the month of January. This means that over half of January's income as shown below is from prepaid pledges. For a detailed financial report, please email the office.
