On behalf of our unhoused clients, we would like to thank everyone who have supported Shower and Laundry Ministry in the past couple of weeks for your generosity!

As mentioned in previous Articles, every week we supply approximately 30 men's t-shirts (sizes M, L, XL), crew socks, and underwear (M, L, XL) and 4 sets of women's t-shirts (M, L, XL), ankle socks and underwear (sizes 5, 6, 7) to our clients. At least 13 loads of laundry (26 pods) are done by our homeless clients, and another 15 loads (30 pods) for the towels and washrags used by our shower coordinators.

The needs of our inventory change from week to week and today we bring you an updated list of items we are currently in need of. Monetary donations to account 3085 are still greatly appreciated because we have sources to buy supplies in bulk at discounted prices, though you are welcome to purchase the items yourself (best prices for all personal hygiene items are offered in Dollar Tree, socks on Amazon or Walmart).
