Rise Against Hunger Update

The meals you packaged have been shipped!

Great news! The meals Asbury packaged are on their way to a community in urgent need of nutrition. Located in the center of Africa, the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is the second largest country in Africa, with the fourth largest population. Despite its many natural resources, corruption and weak institutions have delayed the country's development. Child malnutrition is widespread, and most of the population lives in conditions of moderate to serious food insecurity.


The Global Hunger Index, which assesses food insecurity based on indicators that measure undernourishment and undernutrition, categorizes the DRC as having an "alarming" level of hunger. The meals you packaged will help ensure that children have access to the consistent nourishment they need to live healthy lives and successfully pursue their education. Partners Ending Poverty

Partners for Change equips and empowers people to chart their course out of poverty into self-sustainability through a life skills education and long-term mentorship program. We foster quality community by intentionally developing relationships that bridge socioeconomic lines. The idea is to help people prevent themselves from returning to crisis mode and repetitively seeking assistance from community care providers.

A year ago, we were serving less than 30 participants. With our newest collaboration with Goodness Village, we are currently serving approximately 100 participants. We have 4 different cohorts happening, both in person and via Zoom.

Partners for Change has a 50% matching grant opportunity with CHEF (Community Health and Education Foundation).

We are to raise \$20,000 and they will match us with \$10,000. This is a great opportunity to multiply resources.
