UMCOR Responds to Hawaii Fires

United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) is coordinating the Hawaiian wildfire response through our United Methodist siblings in Hawaii. Like many structures, it appears that the United Methodist Church in Lahaina was destroyed. The focus right now is ensuring the safety of all the people, providing shelter and getting people's basic needs cared for. As we know from the wildfire response in California, UMCOR will work ecumenically and be present in Hawaii for months/years helping people to re-build their lives and their homes. Bishop Dottie Escobedo-Frank, the UMC Bishop of the area, has asked us to funnel all giving through UMCOR: U.S. Domestic Disaster—Hawaii.

Many of us have enjoyed the beautiful islands, and now it's our turn to give them help. Gifts may be made through Asbury through our usual giving methods. Please mark your gift for the Hawaiian wildfires. Thank you.

Asbury Shower and Laundry Ministry needs your help!

Until Vineyard 2.0 is fully open, Asbury will continue to operate the shower and laundry ministry 3 days a week on our campus. Unfortunately, the special benevolence fund (account 3085) that has been used to buy clothing (t-shirts, socks and underwear), personal care items and laundry detergent has been depleted and we can no longer purchase clothing or laundry detergent for this critical mission.

Every week we supply approximately 30 men's t-shirts (sizes M, L, XL), crew socks, and underwear (M, L, XL) and 4 sets of women's t-shirts (M, L, XL), ankle socks and underwear (sizes 5, 6, 7) to our clients. At least 13 loads of laundry (26 pods) are done by our homeless clients, and another 15 loads (30 pods) for the towels and washrags used by our shower patrons.

Please help us keep this ministry going for another 6 months (estimated time until Vineyard 2.0 is open). We can use the following:

- Laundry detergent pods are preferred
- NEW (in package) Men's white t-shirts in size M, L or XL
- NEW (in package) Men's crew socks
- NEW (in package) Men's boxer briefs in size M, L or XL
- Shampoo and Conditioner
- Body Wash
- Deodorant
- Disposable Razors (men's and women's)
- \$\$\$ to account 3085

We have the ability to buy in bulk at reduced prices (tshirts for 'so monetary donations are greatly appreciated!

If you prefer to do your own shopping, Kirkland (Costco) laundry pods are among the least expensive you can get, and Dollar Tree is a great place to buy personal care items.




Palestinian Fundraiser Dinner Sold Out!
