
PASTOR CHAT UPDATE



Dear Church Family,

I want to first tell you that Karen and I are so thankful, excited, and thrilled to be in this wonderful church! As I write this letter, I am starting my eighth week as Lead Pastor at Shalimar UMC. I am very much in a learning mode as I seek to discern where God is at work among us, where He is leading us, and what's next for our mission and ministry as a church for Christ in this community.

As I have been learning about Shalimar, I have had many conversations across the congregation. Along with many exciting things I'm learning, I am also picking up expressions of confusion about "where we are" in regards to the Disaffiliation Process with the Alabama-West Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church. In this letter, I wish to give a brief update to as many people as possible and am certainly willing to come and talk with anyone about these matters – just contact me so I can help you better understand.

January 30, 2023, the Church Council of Shalimar UMC voted to enter the Discernment/Disaffiliation Process which had been created by our Annual Conference leadership, Bishop, and Conference Board of Trustees. This process had been in place since March of 2022. The rationale and our process was based upon a particular paragraph in the UM Book of Discipline, ¶2553, which was adopted and placed in the Discipline in 2019. This paragraph was written and accepted with a "sunset clause"— it's authority allowing churches to leave the denomination for a specific reason will end December 31, 2023.

This paragraph in the Discipline stated that for "reasons of conscience" related to the Discipline's language regarding same-sex unions, ordination of homosexual pastors, and other matters related to human sexuality, local churches could vote to disaffiliate from the larger denomination. However, ¶2553 did not give guidance on how Annual Conferences should carry out disaffiliation. This meant that different Annual Conference Bishops, leaders, and Conference Boards of Trustees across the denomination could set different standards, procedures, applicable to the churches within the bounds of their Conferences.

Bishop David Graves, his Cabinet of District Superintendents, and our Conference Board of Trustees established a process that set requirements for local churches to meet in order to be considered for Disaffiliation. From March 2022 until June 5, 2023, Churches in our Annual Conference were not required to state and certify the actual "reason of conscience" about human sexuality language written in our Book of Discipline as the churches followed the process.

In our Alabama-West Florida Annual Conference, following special Called Annual Conference meetings in May 2022, November 2022 and more recently in May 2023, <u>241 churches have disaffiliated</u> from the UM Church in the Alabama-West Florida Annual Conference. This means that our Annual Conference has lost nearly 48% of it's churches in a little over 12 months.

As a direct consequence of the number of churches who left, our Conference Board of Trustees elected to clarify the guidelines for the process of disaffiliation. These clarifications were submitted accepted at our most recent Months:Annual Conference gathering in Mobile, AL, June 11–14, 2023. So, on June 13, 2023, a New Process came into effect which requires churches such as Shalimar UMC to provide and certify the church's "reason of conscience" for the need to disaffiliate and provide additional information.

Shalimar UMC was already engaged in the process of discernment preparing for the possibility of voting to disaffiliate, following the previous <u>guidelines established in March 2022</u>. The New Process from the Conference Board of Trustees does not contain a "grandfather clause" which recognizes the efforts of churches already in the original process. Therefore, new requirements were added to our church's work as it continues in this New Process.

Between June 15 and July 27, our Church Council met and fulfilled the additional requirements called for in the New Policy. However, the New Process added or changed four elements over which our church has no control:

- One element is a Missional Assessment conducted by a trained team from the Pensacola District,
 United Methodist Church, which studies and reports on Shalimar UMC's effectiveness and place in it's
 community as we carry out the mission of the United Methodist Church. This assessment seeks to
 determine if the mission of the UMC will be <u>helped or harmed</u> if Shalimar UMC ceases to be a United
 Methodist Church. The parameters of this assessment are found in ¶213 of the UM Book of Discipline.
- The second element in the New Process relates to three windows of time, or timelines.
 - Shalimar UMC had to rapidly collate minutes of meetings, reports, and membership contact information to be submitted by a certain date. <u>This was accomplished</u>.
 - There is a 30-day window during which the Missional Assessment Team is to conduct their study
 and issue a report to the Conference Board of Trustees. I have been informed that this
 assessment has been scheduled, but was given no detail about when it would do it's study.
 Shalimar UMC does not know when this 30-day window begins or ends.
 - 3. Once the Conference Board of Trustees receives the required information from Shalimar UMC, it must also receive the Missional Assessment. At the time that these items are both collected by the Trustees, they have a 30-day window of time to study the information and issue direction to our District Superintendent, Rev. Jean Tippit, about whether she may or may not schedule a required Church Conference where all Professing Members are asked to be in attendance to vote about disaffiliation. Since I do not have any information about the timing of the Missional Assessment, I don't know when the Trustees' time window begins and ends.
- The third element is after our District Superintendent receives instruction from the Conference Board of Trustees, Rev. Tippit will then need to coordinate with our Leadership and me about scheduling a Church Conference in order to hold a disaffiliation vote.
- The final element is crucial a firm deadline. All the above information must be reviewed, formatted, and prepared for presentation to Lay and Clergy delegates to the Called Annual Conference which will take place on November 12, 2023. This deadline is October 15, 2023.

As you may discern, the clarifications which were amended at Annual Conference in June have actually served to cause our Church Family to feel "frozen in time." Many of us wonder what is next. According to my understanding of the New Process, Shalimar UMC is simply waiting to hear ultimately if the District Superintendent will have instructions to schedule our Church Conference. Due to Rev. Tippit's schedule, I believe that our Leadership and I will hear about scheduling a vote in a Church Conference during the first week of September.

Please feel free, as I said earlier in this update, to contact me if I can help you understand further any of the issues surrounding the process in which we are engaged. I'm not waiting for anything, myself. I am pushing forward and asking you to join me as we continue to be the Church, carry out our mission, and tell and show others the immense love of God in Jesus Christ.


