Apprenticeship Process:

1 Starting the Journey

Begins with a connection between leader and apprentice, agreement that God is raising up that leader, and a commitment to journey together.


2 Journeying Together

Consists of ongoing discipleship and training according to the three C's (Coaching, Context, and Content).

3 Continuing the Journey


Goes beyond the apprenticeship process, a relationship of ongoing care and continuing education that persists.

The Three C's



Coach

The coaching relationship between the apprentice and the leader is the vehicle that facilitates the leadership development process.




Context

- The apprentice must be connected to and immersed in the culture.
- The apprentice is given responsibilities within the group, not tasks.
- The apprentice practices carrying the culture into community and learns from the coach.







Content

- The coach and apprentice decide the curriculum that is relevant to the needs of the apprentice.*
- MVVC provides content for understanding and carrying MVVC culture and vision.
- MVVC provides a curated list of other resources for the benefit of the apprentice and coach.
