- Be the primary advocate for Kids Ministry, inspiring the entire church body to invest in children's lives.

Outreach

- Plan and lead community outreach events (VBS, Trunk or Treat, Family Movie Night).
- Assist in after-school Bible clubs and school partnerships to engage with local children.
