SUMMER GREETINGS COUFRIENDS,

As the summer activities wind down and our kids return to school, please be sure to mark your calendar for our upcoming Genogram weekend Sept 5-6, the next step towards Integral Ministry. We are blessed to welcome Drs. Revs. Gary and Jane Simmons, co-creators of The Quantum Living Process and the Integral Ministry Practice program, as facilitators.

The Genogram is an activity to create our community's Q Card which contains both the qualities of who we have come here to be and highlights the unhealed shadow qualities that can arise in times of change and conflict.

The Genogram can be a living curriculum for the ministry insofar as the church's "story" is a reminder of what gets created when the community has lost its way. Just as each individual monitors their own internal state and takes responsibility for their perception and meaning making, the community monitors their own response to community issues in the broader context of history repeating itself. The community can be resilient in the face of circumstances reminiscent of a past hurt by shifting quickly into the awareness of expressing who they have come here to be as a ministry.

With respect to the Genogram, eras moving forward will no longer be defined by a minister's tenure, but by the specific mission of the ministry. Within any particular "mission era" there will be things that the community accomplishes (prouds), and things that happen where the community falls short of fulfilling its purpose (regrets). The legacy that gets created is associated with the community's capacity to be true to their word and intentions.

This requires an elevated expression of emotional and spiritual maturity, as well as cohesiveness, integrity, and self-responsibility. While there can be ups and downs, challenges and difficulties, setbacks and surprises, there is little room for drama.

This weekend is open to everyone who considers COU their spiritual home — whether for a few weeks or a few decades. It works best when most people are familiar with the Quantum Living Process.

In preparation for this weekend, we are encouraging anyone who hasn't been exposed to this shadow work to participate in this 6-week class beginning on August 9th.






New Series: The Tao of Pooh


