1. Pray.
2. Read all of assigned chapter in one sitting.
3. Read the assigned passage at least 7 times.
4. Survey the context of the assigned passage (Immediate, Book, Bible).
5. Copy & paste the assigned text into a word document (update this throughout the process).
6. Observe the text.
7. Study the key words, syntax, and grammar.
8. Note especially commands, present tense verbs, perfect tense verbs, rare word forms, key theological concepts, repeated words/phrases/concepts, parallel statements, et.
9. Read several English translations (ESV, NASB, LSB, NIV, NKJV).
10. Look up all cross references in each translation.
11. Keep personal notes in the same word document.
12. Read the notes on your text in a good study bible (MacArthur Study Bible, ESV Study Bible, NIV Study Bible).
13. Take time to prayerfully apply the text to your own life.
14. Come ready to discuss what you learned.
