

YOUR KINGDOM COME

Matthew 6:9-13: Pray, then, in this way: Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

The Lord's Prayer remains one of the most widely known prayers within the Christian faith. When the disciples asked Jesus how to pray, He laid out a clear map for how to approach God through prayer. As we journey together through these 7 Days of Prayer, we can even dig deeper into this prayer model that Jesus gave His disciples. This model prayer powerfully expresses our needs and the needs of the world around us. We belong to a Heavenly Father who loves us, who is all powerful, and able to provide everything we need in this life and the one to come. He forgives our sins, delivers us from the darkness in the world, gives us our daily bread and we can join with him in prayer today and say, "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done!"

PRAYER

Thank you, Heavenly Father that we can glorify your Name as we set ourselves to seek you corporately in this week of prayer. We declare that your Kingdom will be established through our prayers as your church prays in agreement. We pray with great expectation of the transformation that will come about because of our prayers this week. Guide us, Holy Spirit and inspire each one of us as we pray. In Jesus Name, Amen.



LOVE IN ACTION IS FAITH EXPRESSED.

Colossians 1:4-5 ...because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints, the faith and love that spring from the hope that is stored up for you in heaven and that you have already heard about in the word of truth, the gospel.

We have a relational God who loves the friendships and the loving communities that are established in His church. When outsiders see us exercising love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (fruits of the Spirit Galatians 5:22-23) toward one another, they see that the relationship we profess to have with Jesus, has made a profound difference in our lives. Love in action is faith expressed. In other words, your love for one another demonstrates the love of Christ to a world desperately in need of his love. We are a family in Christ, with spiritual bonds that go beyond normal family bonds. By showing his love to those of the household of God and to outsiders, we demonstrate His presence in our lives.

Holy Spirit help us to build healthy, strong friendships with other Christ followers. We pray that we can grow in love and faith to express the heart of Jesus through our lives. We also pray that those whom we meet in our daily lives who don't know you, will see that we are his followers by the love we share and the respectful way we treat each other. We ask this in Jesus Name, Amen.





NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR GOD

Jeremiah 32:17 Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

Matthew 19:26 Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

You have probably read or heard these scriptures before. When we think of these verses and the truth revealed through them, the level of excitement and expectation in our hearts is indescribable. These verses promise that we have the privilege of serving a God who can literally do anything, and there is nothing that is impossible for Him. This is a credible fact. Psalm 50:15-16 Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High, and call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honour me.

Jeremiah 33:3 Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'

Matthew 7:7 Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

Wow, what an invitation to us! Ask, seek, knock. This is an open invitation to come to our Heavenly Father and ask and to keep on asking! We don't know what you are desiring from God at this time in your life but whatever it is, don't give up! Matthew 7 tells us that God is a kind and gracious Father who desires to give good gifts to His children. We all have personal needs, whether financial, relational, or spiritual. Have a look at the suggested list below. What is your personal ask of God? It may be on the list; it may be something that isn't. Whatever it is, trust that as you pray for others during these seven days, God is working on your behalf. When Job prayed for his friends after his long ordeal, the Lord gave him double what he had before.

Here are some suggestions to put on your Ask List:

- A home/car
- A job or new job
- Healing in my body
- Healing in my mind and emotions
- Freedom from addictive behaviour
- I pray for my spouse (or for a spouse if you are single)
- A child/children
- Salvation for a loved one
- Financial breakthrough

And whatever else the Holy Spirit prompts you to put on your list.
