

What Does It Mean to Be Baptized?

Baptism is a sacred and personal declaration of your faith and belief in Jesus Christ - it's an act of **obedience**, **faith**, and **surrender**.

When you're baptized in **the name of Jesus Christ** (Acts 2:38, KJV), you are publicly identifying with His **death, burial, and resurrection** (Romans 6:4, KJV), for the remission "removal" of all your past sins (Acts 2:16, KJV). Baptism marks the start of a **new life**, and signifies that you now walk in covenant with God.

This spiritual rebirth is part of the salvation plan laid out in Scripture and modeled by the early Church. It's the next step in fully surrendering your life to Jesus—and we are here to celebrate that step with you!

Key Scriptures (KJV)

Acts 2:38 - "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins..."

Romans 6:4 – "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up... even so we also should walk in newness of life."

Acts 22:16 - "Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

Baptism FAQs

Do I have to be baptized again if I was baptized as a baby or in a different way?

We follow the biblical pattern of water baptism by full immersion in the name of Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38, KJV). If you've never been baptized this way, we invite you to take this step according to the Word.

What should I bring?

A white shirt is desired, but not required. Bring anything you need to feel comfortable.

Can my family and friends come?

Absolutely! This is a celebration. We encourage you to invite your loved ones to witness this life-changing

moment.

What happens after I'm baptized?

We'll walk with you through the next steps of praying to receive the Holy Ghost, and growth in your faith journey. You're not alone—we're in this together.
