KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

WORSHIP

- Provide on-site musical leadership for all church services
- Manage the scheduling of volunteers and hired musicians via Planning Center Online.
 - *Prepare songs and service elements for the weekly gathering.*
 - *Maintain weekly communication with musicians and sound staff.*
 - *Prepare click tracks and multi-tracks for services.*
 - *Print and prepare worship service materials (schedules, scripture readings, music sheets, etc.).*

- Lead mid-week rehearsals for the worship team.
- Collaborate with the Music Ministry Assistant to coordinate services.

ADMINISTRATION

- Participate in weekly service planning meetings.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Meet weekly one-on-one with the Music Ministry Assistant.
- Prepare the stage and sound for all upcoming services.
- Supervise all tech and sound maintenance and upgrades.
- Collaborate with the media liaison on the leadership team to provide a live stream and media volunteers.
- Oversee and curate a canon of classic hymns, modern hymns, and contemporary worship for MCC liturgy.
- Manage the backend of PCO, ensuring volunteers and schedules are updated.
- Oversee the budget for all music areas and submit monthly expense reports.

- **Active** in the life of the church.
- Experience **leading worship vocally and instrumentally** (piano and/or guitar preferred).

- Basic knowledge of **AV equipment and worship software** (Planning Center, ProPresenter, Keynote, etc.).
