**Take Your Next Step** — Maybe it's saying yes to Jesus, getting baptized, joining the church, or finally attending Starting Point. Don't put it off. Start this year by moving forward.

As a church, we're stepping into a season of new beginnings. We're praying, preparing, and trusting God to lead us to the next Lead Pastor He has for us. And I believe He's preparing us as a church in the process.

## ACTS: A Framework for Prayer

Prayer can sometimes feel overwhelming—especially if you're not sure where to begin or how to stay focused. While there is no single "right" way to pray, one simple and meaningful approach we recommend is the ACTS method. This method provides a helpful framework to guide your time with God and create a consistent rhythm of prayer.

ACTS stands for Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, and Supplication.

- **Adoration** begins by praising God for who He is—His character, His faithfulness, and His goodness. Psalm 103:1 reminds us to bless the Lord with all that is within us.
- **Confession** invites honest reflection, acknowledging our sin and bringing it before God with humility and repentance (James 5:16).
- **Thanksgiving** shifts our hearts toward gratitude, expressing thanks for God's blessings, provision, and grace in our lives (Psalm 69:30).
- **Supplication** is the act of bringing our requests to God—praying earnestly for our needs and the needs of others with trust and dependence (Philippians 4:6).

As you pray this month, we encourage you to use the ACTS method as you walk through the prayer guides on the following pages. Whether your prayers are long or brief, this simple pattern can help you pray with intention, focus, and a deeper awareness of God's presence.

### Lead Pastor Search Team Update

Church, we have been asking you to commit to praying daily for our church and for our Pastor Search Team. Thank you for partnering with us in prayer, and please do not stop. God does not tell us what He is going to do – He reveals to us who He is. So far, our team has met twice and is currently working to complete the Congregation Survey and the Lead Pastor Job Description. # FIRST & FAST

## A Posture of Dependence: Prayer and Fasting

Throughout Scripture, prayer and fasting are closely connected practices that help God's people seek Him with humility, dependence, and focus. Prayer is how we commune with God—listening, confessing, thanking, and asking—while fasting is the intentional setting aside of physical comfort to heighten our spiritual attentiveness. Together, they express a heart posture that says we need God more than anything else.

At Connection Point, we practice a rhythm of these spiritual disciplines through First & Fast. Each month, we gather on the first Sunday evening to pray together, lifting a variety of needs before the Lord. Then, on the following Monday, we fast in unity and pray through a specific list of requests for our church. You'll find those focused prayer points on this page as we seek God together.

If you are reading this on January 4, you know we're beginning the year with a unique First & Fast gathering during our Sunday




