Galatians 1:6-10. Pray
gospel truth, not
political opinions,
would reign supremely
clear in the church.

22

Meditate on

John 17:20-23. Pray
love for, trust in, and
devotion to Jesus
would unify the church
amidst a politically
divisive time.

23

Meditate on

Exodus 18:18-23. Pray
for leaders in our
country who fear God,
are trustworthy, do not
seek selfish gain, and
promote peace.

24

Meditate on **Deuteronomy 17:14-20**.

Pray for leaders to hear and obey God's Word, to avoid greed, adultery, and idolatry, to fear and submit to God's authority, and to demonstrate humility before God and those they lead.

25

Meditate on

Judges 17:6 and 21:25.

Pray God would help us to live and govern in our country according to what is right in His eyes, not our eyes.

Repent of ways you are thinking, desiring, or living according to what is right in your eyes.

26

Meditate on
Proverbs 21:1. Praise
God for His sovereignty
over leaders in our
country, and pray He
would turn their hearts
and lives for the good
of many and the glory
of His name.

27

Meditate on

Psalm 72:1-7. Pray for
just leaders who

"defend the cause of
the poor, give
deliverance to the
children of the needy,
and crush oppressors."

First pray. Then vote.

28

Meditate on

James 1:5-8. Pray for
wisdom as you apply
God's Word to how you
will steward your vote.

29

Meditate on

Proverbs 2:9-15. Pray
for wise leaders who
fear God and discern
carefully between
good and evil,
righteousness and
wickedness, and
honesty and
dishonesty.

30

Meditate on

Mark 12:13-17. Pray God
would give us wisdom
to appropriately honor
our government
(including our
government leaders)
while ultimately
glorifying Him.

31

Meditate on
Philippians 3:20-21
and 1 Peter 2:11-12. Pray
we would ultimately
live as foreigners in
this country whose
citizenship is in heaven
and whose priorities
are focused on the
world to come.

NOVEMBER

Meditate on **Ephesians 4:1-6**. Pray for unity in the church around Jesus and His Word amidst the toxic political climate in our country.

Meditate on

1 Peter 2:13-17. Pray we will live as submissive citizens of our government with ultimate submission to God.

Meditate on

Micah 6:8. Pray God

would help us as the
church and as a
country to do justice,
love kindness, and

walk humbly with Him.

4

Meditate on

Matthew 6:9-10 and

Revelation 22:20-21. As
you cast your ballot,
pray for Jesus to return
soon to usher in His
kingdom of perfect
justice and
righteousness in all the
earth.

On the day after the election, meditate on **1 Timothy 2:1-6**. Pray for the newly elected. Pray God will help you, and all of us, to appropriately honor our government leaders, to continually pray for them, to work charitably with them for the good of others according to God's Word, and to live ultimately for the spread of God's love in the gospel throughout our nation and to all nations.
