Last week we learned that hope rises because Emmanuel—God with us—steps into our silence and waiting. But the story doesn't stop at His arrival. When Jesus comes near, He also takes His place as King, and His reign brings something powerful into our lives: joy.

Discussion Questions

1) He Reigns with Grace (Psalm 98:4–6)

- What is the difference between happiness and biblical joy?
- Psalm 98 describes all creation responding to the reign of the King. Why do you think joy is connected to His rule?
- Where in your life do you need Jesus to “reign with grace” instead of pressure, fear, or self-effort?

2) He Breaks the Curse (Romans 5:17)

- Romans 5:17 says we “reign in life” through Jesus. What do you think that means?
- What lies or patterns try to steal your joy or push you back into a bondage mindset?
- How does remembering what Jesus has already conquered help you walk in confidence and joy?

3) He Fills the Earth with Glory (Luke 2:10–11)

- Why is joy a natural response to Jesus' presence?
- The angels announced “good news of great joy for all people.” How does this shape the way we share Jesus with others?
- How can your life reflect the glory and joy of Jesus this week in practical ways—home, work, school, conversations?

Living It Out

Jesus' reign brings joy—not because life is perfect, but because the King is faithful. This week, be intentional about letting His joy rise in you and show through you.

This Week's Practices:

1. **Pause daily and pray:** “Jesus, reign in me today. Restore joy in every place of my life.”
2. **Write down** one area where you need His peace and one where you've seen His goodness.
3. **Share** something God has done with one person—joy grows when shared.
4. **Play “Joy to the World”** during your devotion time and remind your heart: The King has come. He is reigning.
