Cookie Policy

This cookies policy explains how our website uses cookies and similar technologies to collect information when you use our website. By using the website <https://greatdividecalvary.org>, you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with this policy.

What Cookies are:

Cookies are small pieces of information that your browser automatically stores in your device's memory (computer, tablet, or mobile) when you browse the internet. We use cookies and allow third parties to use this technology on our website. Cookies contain various data, such as information about the pages viewed, the frequency of page views and the actions you have performed on our website, to improve your browsing experience, and deliver relevant advertising. This data is pseudonymized by technical precautions so that it is not readily possible for us to assign the data to a specific user.

How we use Cookies:

- **Essential cookies:** These cookies are necessary for the website to fully function and cannot be turned off. They are normally only set in response to actions made by you, like logging in or filling out one of our forms. It is possible to set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, however, some parts of the website might not function properly as a result.

- **Analytics cookies:** These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our website. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the website. All information these cookies collect is completely anonymous.

Cookie Management:

Cookies are manageable through the settings of your internet browser. You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to switch off all cookies. You can also delete cookies that have already been set. But again, if you switch off the cookies, the website might not function properly.

Legal Compliance:

We comply with the Colorado Privacy Act (CPA) with regard to our use of cookies. This means that we will only use cookies with your consent at any time (except in cases where cookies are necessary for the website to function properly), and we will provide you with clear and comprehensive information about the cookies we use.
