## **EXAMPLE:**

## **Supernatural Gifts of the Spirit**

These gifts are who you are. They can be developed by spending more time with the Lord and in Scripture. These gifts are to use in your day to day and in small group life.

## A. Discernment/Wisdom/Knowledge

The gift of discernment/wisdom is the divine strength or ability to spiritually identify falsehood and to distinguish between right and wrong motives and situations and to make wise decisions.

Matthew 16:21-23; Acts 5:1-11, 16:16-18; 1 Corinthians 12:10; 1 John 4:1-6, Acts 6:3,10; 1 Corinthians 2:6-13, 12:8

### B. Faith

The gift of faith is the divine strength or ability to believe in God for unseen supernatural results in every arena of life.

Acts 11:22-24; Romans 4:18-21; 1 Corinthians 12:9; Hebrews 11

## **C.** Healing/Miracles

The gift of healing/miracles is the divine strength or ability to act as an intermediary in faith, prayer, and by the laying-on of hands for the healing of physical and mental illnesses.

Acts 3:1-10, 9:32-35, 28:7-10; 1 Corinthians 12:9, 28,Acts 9:36-42, 19:11-12, 20:7-12; Romans 15:18-19; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28



### **D.** Mercy

The gift of mercy is the divine strength or ability to feel empathy and to care for those who are hurting in any way.

Matthew 9:35-36; Mark 9:41; Romans 12:8; 1 Thessalonians 5:14

#### E. Prophecy

The gift of prophecy is the divine strength or ability to boldly speak and bring clarity to scriptural and doctrinal truth, in some cases foretelling God's plan.

Acts 2:37-40, 7:51-53, 26:24-29; 1 Corinthians 14:1-4; 1 Thessalonians 1:5

## **F.** Tongues (and Interpretation)

The gift of tongues is the divine strength or ability to pray in a heavenly language to encourage your spirit and to commune with God. The gift of tongues is often accompanied by interpretation and should be used in order and appropriately.

Acts 2:1-13; 1 Corinthians 12:10, 14:1-14

## **Ministry Gifts**

These gifts are to advance the kingdom by serving. You can use these gifts in one of our Serve Teams or in your small group life. These are developed by practice and patience.

#### **G.** Administration

The gift of administration is the divine strength or ability to organize multiple tasks and groups of people to accomplish these tasks.

Luke 14:28-30; Acts 6:1-7; 1 Corinthians 12:28

#### H. Craftsmanship

The gift of craftsmanship is the divine strength or ability to plan, build and work with your hands in construction environments to accomplish multiple ministry applications.

Exodus 30:22, 31:3-11; 2 Chronicles 34:9-13; Acts 18:2-3

## I. Evangelism/Missionary (Equipping gift)

The gift of evangelism/missions is the divine strength or ability to help non-Christians take the necessary steps to becoming Christ followers both here and abroad.

Acts 8:5-6, 8:26-40, 14:21, 21:8; Ephesians 4:11-14, Acts 8:4, 13:2-3, 22:21; Romans 10:15

#### **J.** Exhortation

The gift of exhortation is the divine strength or ability to encourage others through the written or spoken word and Biblical truth.

Acts 14:22; Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 4:13; Hebrews 10:24-25



#### **K.** Giving

The gift of giving is the divine strength or ability to produce wealth and to give by tithes and offerings for the purpose of advancing the Kingdom of God on earth.

Mark 12:41-44: Romans 12:8: 2 Corinthians 8:1-7. 9:2-7

## L. Hospitality/Service

The gift of hospitality/service is the divine strength or ability to create warm, welcoming environments for others in places such as your home, office, or church.

Acts 16:14-15; Romans 12:13, 16:23; Hebrews 13:1-2; 1 Peter 4:9, Mark 15:40-41; Acts 9:36; Romans 16:1-2; 1 Corinthians 12:2

## M. Music/Worship

The gift of music/worship is the divine strength or ability to sing, dance, or play an instrument primarily for the purpose of helping others worship God.

Deuteronomy 31:22; 1 Samuel 16:16; 1 Chronicles 16:41-42; 2 Chronicles 5:12-13, 34:12; Psalm 150

## N. Pastoral/Leadership (Equipping gift)

The gift of pastor/leadership is the divine strength or ability to influence people at their level while directing and focusing them on the big picture, vision, or idea.

John 10:1-18; Ephesians 4:11-14; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-3, Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 3:1-13, 5:17; Hebrews 13:17

## O. Apostleship (Equipping gift)

The gift of pastor/leadership is the divine strength or ability to pioneer new churches and ministries through planting, overseeing, and training.

Acts 15:22-35; 1 Corinthians 12:28; 2 Corinthians 12:12; Galatians 2:7-10; Ephesians 4:11-14

## P. Teaching (Equipping gift)

The gift of teaching is the divine strength or ability to study and learn from the Scriptures primarily to bring understanding and growth to other Christians.

Acts 18:24-28, 20:20-21; 1 Corinthians 12:28; Ephesians 4:11-14
