Opening Prayer

Key Takeaways:

1. Being wild about Jesus means worshiping passionately and without inhibition.
2. Bold faith requires trusting God in difficult situations and refusing to compromise.

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean to you to be "wild about Jesus"? How does this differ from a "tame" faith?
2. The message mentioned David dancing before the Lord with all his might. How comfortable are you with expressive worship? What holds you back from worshiping more freely?
3. Reflect on the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. When have you faced a situation where you had to choose between pleasing God or pleasing others? How did you respond?
4. How can we demonstrate "radical love" in our daily lives? Share an example of when you've seen someone show this kind of love.
5. Pastor Mike mentioned that being wild for Jesus might make others uncomfortable. Have you experienced this? How do you balance being bold in your faith while still being respectful of others?
6. What areas of your life do you feel God calling you to be more "wild" or bold in your faith? What's holding you back?

Practical Applications:

1. **Worship Challenge:** This week, try a new form of worship that pushes you out of your comfort zone (e.g., raising hands, kneeling, dancing).
2. **Bold Faith Action:** Identify one area where you've been compromising your faith. Make a plan to stand firm in that area this week.
3. **Radical Love Project:** As a group, brainstorm and plan a service project to show God's love to an "unlovable" group in your community.
4. **Unashamed Testimony:** Practice sharing your testimony with each other. Challenge yourselves to share it with at least one person outside the group this week.
5. **Prayer Partners:** Pair up and commit to praying for each other daily, specifically for boldness in faith.
