“Discovering God’s Will”

- God’s Sovereign will. God has a predetermined plan for everything that happens in the universe. This is sometimes called God’s secret will or hidden will since He doesn’t necessarily reveal it to His people, although occasionally we may catch a glimpse of it.
- God’s Moral will. In this area we have what God wanted us to know. His moral will are the revealed commands in the Bible that teach how men ought to believe and live. The Bible is the Christian’s compass and final authority.
