In a culture saturated with entertainment, it's easy to assume that keeping kids engaged in church means keeping them constantly amused. But kids don't need flashy lights or endless games to encounter Jesus—they need discipleship. They need leaders and mentors who will walk with them, open Scripture with them, answer their questions, and pray over them. Fun can be a tool, but faith is the goal. The heart of children's ministry is not about filling time; it's about forming hearts. What we plant in a child's heart today can take root and bear fruit for a lifetime.

Because children are so open to the gospel, this window of influence is one of the most strategic in all of ministry. Studies consistently show that the majority of people who choose to follow Jesus do so before the age of 13. That means children's ministry isn't just a support program—it's frontline missions.

Every Bible story taught, every prayer whispered, every conversation had in a small group or hallway matters deeply. When we recognize this spiritual receptivity in children and prioritize intentional discipleship, we don't just grow our ministries—we grow the Church.
