- Reduces delays and unexpected costs as the time of implementation.

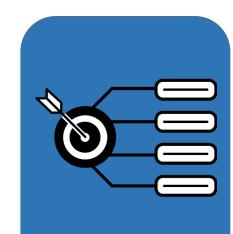

169 PARKING SPACES 21 - PARKING LOT 148 - STREET PARKING













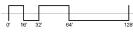

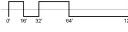

200 PARKING SPACES 86 - PARKING LOT 114 - STREET PARKING

















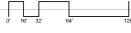
ARCHITECTS

228 PARKING SPACES 125 - PARKING LOT 103 - STREET PARKING

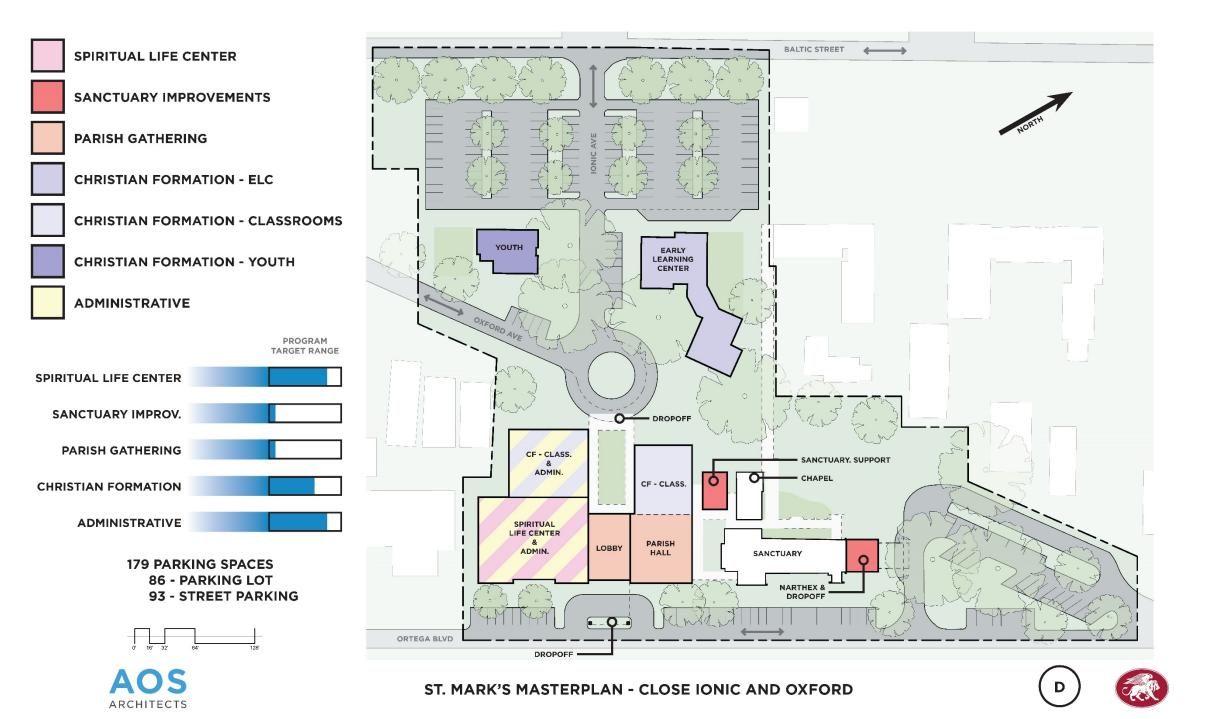












- Connects major spaces without street crossings

- Most parking is remote

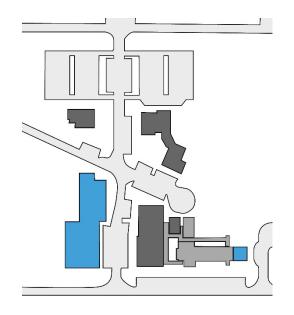


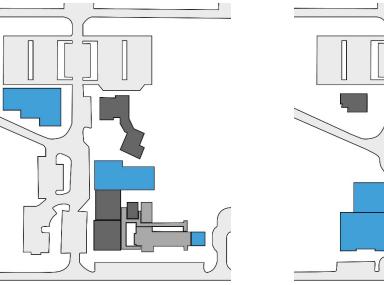


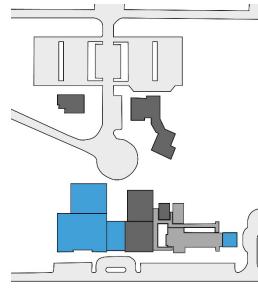










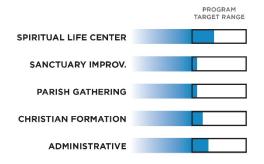


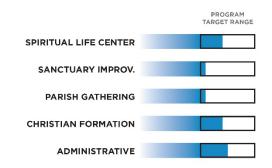

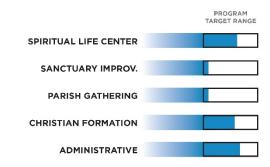

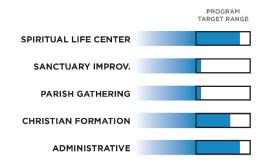
C Close Oxford
