Keep me from empty offerings and lead me into authentic obedience. Let my heart reflect your character in all I do. I long to walk closely with you every day. You promise that those who oppose me will be no more, and I will rejoice in your deliverance. Give me courage to face each day, knowing you are near. Let my strength be found in you alone. Amen.</div>
<div>3</div> <div>Psalms 56:1-13</div> <div>Father, when I am afraid, I will put my trust in you. You see my tears and count each step I take—you are for me and will not let me fall. Strengthen my heart to walk in your light, free from fear. I will praise you for your faithful love and deliverance. Amen.</div>	<div>4</div> <div>Isaiah 41:8-10</div> <div>God, you call me your servant and promise that I am not alone. When I feel weak or discouraged, remind me that you hold me by the hand. Thank you for being my strength and help. I rest in the security of your presence. Teach me to be mindful of how my actions affect those around me. May my choices reflect love, integrity, and a desire to build others up. Let all I do be done with grace and purpose. Amen.</div>	<div>6</div> <div>Deuteronomy 31:1-8</div> <div>Faithful God, you go before me and will never leave me. When I am uncertain or afraid, remind me to be strong and courageous in you. Just as you were with Moses and Joshua, you are with me now. I place my trust in your unchanging presence. Help me to trust in what I cannot yet see, knowing your Word will never return empty. Let your truth take root in my heart and accomplish all you desire in me. I yield to your perfect will. You do not abandon those who cry out to you. Let me walk in the confidence of your saving grace. May I reflect your kindness in both word and deed. Let generosity be a joy and a mark of my faith. As you comfort me, help me extend that same grace to others in their trials. Let my suffering not be wasted but used to bring encouragement and hope. May we share both in Christ’s suffering and his comfort. Amen.</div>	<div>23</div> <div>Isaiah 58:5-11</div> <div>Lord, help me to live out a past that pleases you—one that frees the oppressed, feeds the hungry, and shelters the broken. Let my worship be more than words; may it be justice in action. Guide me continually and satisfy my soul in dry places. Make my life like a well-watered garden. Amen.</div>

When I come to my senses, you run to meet me with open arms. Restore in me the joy of belonging to you. May I never forget the power of your grace. Amen.</div>	<div>25</div> <div>Philippians 2:12-18</div> <div>Lord, help me to live out my salvation with reverence and purpose. Shine through me so that I may be a light in a world that needs hope. Teach me to do all things without grumbling, and to hold fast to your Word. I rejoice in the work you are doing in me. Amen.</div>	<div>26</div> <div>Psalms 118:19-24</div> <div>God, I enter your gates with thanksgiving and rejoice in this day you have made. Thank you for hearing my cries and becoming my salvation. Let me celebrate the goodness of your presence and trust in your perfect timing. You are my strength and song. Thank you for your mercy that does not condemn me. Through Jesus Christ, I find deliverance and hope. Help me lean on your grace daily. Amen.</div>	<div>30</div> <div>Luke 13:6-9</div> <div>Lord, you are patient and merciful, giving time for growth and fruitfulness. Help me not to waste the season I’m in but to bear the fruit of your Spirit. Cultivate my heart and make me ready to respond to your care. May my life bring honor to you. Amen.</div>
