1 <i>Psalm 96:1-6</i> Lord, thank you for your power and glory. Let me sing your praises. Lord, I give you the glory due your name. Let my life, actions and words represent you, showing you are the one and only God. Amen.	2 <i>2 Corinthians 12:9-10</i> Lord, your grace is sufficient for us. When we feel weak or overwhelmed, let us remember that your power is at work within us. We will remain strong because you are with us. Amen.	3 <i>Acts 1:1-5</i> We give thanks for your teachings and thank you that your work continues through us today. As the disciples waited, we to desire to gather together in prayer, asking for the promise you made: the gift of your Holy Spirit. Amen.	4 <i>Matthew 20:1-16</i> Help us accept the gift you give us with humble hearts. Forgive us moments of envy and help us rest in your abundant goodness. May we serve faithfully knowing that all we receive is undeserved grace. Amen.	5 <i>Psalm 111:1-10</i> Let us praise the Lord with all our hearts. Thank you Lord for being compassionate to all who fear you. Help us, Lord, to honor your wonderful name, and may our worship reflect your greatness. Amen.	6 <i>Matthew 6:5-15</i> Lord I come before you, not to be seen by others, but to be known by you. Let me live in a way that honors you and brings your kingdom to earth as it is in heaven. Lord please forgive my sins and let me forgive those who have wronged me. Protect me from temptation and rescue me from evil. Amen	7 <i>1 Kings 17:8-16</i> Heavenly Father, you are my provider. I offer you what I have with the knowledge that you will never let my provisions run dry. Lord, I will obey your word, and trust in you today, tomorrow and always. Amen.
8 <i>Matthew 14:13-23</i> Thank you Lord for your compassion when you see the hungry, and for providing when it seems impossible. Help us trust in you in moments of need and to obey when the task seems overwhelming. Lord please quiet our hearts in your presence. Amen.	9 <i>Psalm 121:1-8</i> Lord, we lift our eyes to you, maker of heaven and earth, knowing that you are our strength. We know our help does not come from what we see, but from you alone. Thank you for being our constant guardian, watching over every step we take. We trust you Lord, our Keeper. Amen.	10 <i>Jeremiah 29:11-13</i> When we cannot see the way forward, help us to trust in your unfailing love and intentions for us. Lord, teach us to wait in faith, to pray with expectation, and to seek you with our whole being. Lord help us feel your presence daily, letting your peace fill us. Amen.	11 <i>James 5:13-16</i> Gracious God, we turn to you in every season—when we are suffering and when we are rejoicing. Strengthen our faith, Lord. Let us pray powerful, faithful prayers that bring restoration and forgiveness knowing that our prayers rest in you. Amen.	12 <i>Psalm 61:2-5</i> Lord, I cry out to you. You are my refuge and my shelter from the enemy. Lead me to the safety of your presence where I long to dwell forever. Fill my heart with hope and remind me that I belong to you. Amen.	13 <i>Isaiah 38:9-20</i> Merciful God, in our weakness and distress we turn our faces towards you. You alone know the weight of our anguish. You are the one who lifts us up, who forgives our sins, and restores our lives by your grace. Lord, thank you for turning our anguish into praise. Amen.	14 <i>Psalm 139:7-18</i> Lord, thank you for knowing us completely. You formed each of us with care and purpose, and every day of our lives is held in your hand. We live in gratitude for the life you have given us. Amen.
15 <i>Job 1:13-22</i> Sovereign Lord, in moments of loss and devastation we come before you with open hearts. We do not question or curse you, but instead we bow before you. Amen.	16 <i>James 2:1-13</i> Heavenly Father, teach us to see others as you see them. Shape our lives by your mercy. As you have been gracious to us, let us extend that grace to others. Help us live as people who show love to all. Amen.	17 <i>Matthew 6:25-30</i> Lord, thank you for teaching us that our lives are worth more than the food we eat or the clothes we wear. We place our needs and our hearts before you, knowing you will provide all that we need. Amen.	18 <i>Isaiah 43:18-21</i> Gracious God, we pray to have the strength to forget the past, and to open our hearts to what you are doing now. You are making a new way for us, so let us see your hand at work. We trust you. Amen.	19 <i>Romans 12:1-8</i> Heavenly Father, we ask that you teach us to live humbly and sincerely, not valuing ourselves over others. Help us use the gifts you have entrusted in us so they reflect your love. Amen.	20 <i>Psalm 139:1-6</i> Gracious God, help me to open my heart to you. You know every part of me already, for it is you who created me. Lead me not to hide, but welcome you into my life and follow you. Amen.	21 <i>Deuteronomy 34:9-12</i> God, I remember you created the whole world, parted the seas, and fed your children mana from heaven.
