LEADERSHIP TEAM

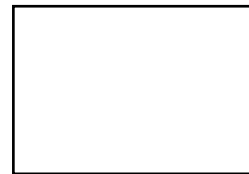
Church of the Servant's Leadership Team governs the congregation's work and ministry.
