Let my love for others reflect the deep love you’ve shown me. Teach me that every command flows from these two greatest truths. Fill me with compassion, humility, and grace in every interaction. Amen.	2 <i>2 Corinthians 12:1-10</i> God, in my weakness, may your strength shine through. I surrender my need to be strong and ask for grace that is sufficient. Remind me that your power is made perfect in the places I struggle. I will boast in you, knowing that when I am weak, then I am strong. Amen.	3 <i>Psalms 94:16-23</i> Lord, when I feel overwhelmed or alone, you are my help and my comfort. You hold me up when my foot slips and steady my heart with your love. You are my refuge and strong defender against all that opposes me. Thank you for being my safe place. Amen.	4 <i>Hebrews 10:19-25</i> Father, thank you for giving me full access to your presence through Jesus. Let me draw near with a sincere heart and unwavering faith. Help me to hold on to hope and encourage others in love and good deeds. May I never neglect the joy of gathering with your people. Amen.
5 <i>Luke 14:15-23</i> Lord, thank you for inviting me to your banquet of grace. Help me not to make excuses, but to accept your invitation with joy. Use me to extend that same invitation to others, especially those who feel left out. Fill your house, Lord, and let none go hungry. Amen.	6 <i>Matthew 7:24-27</i> God, build my life on the solid rock of your Word. When storms come, keep me grounded in truth and obedience. Help me not to merely hear, but to live out what you teach. I trust you to be my foundation and strength. Amen.	7 <i>John 15:1-6</i> Jesus, you are the true vine, and I long to remain in you. Prune away what does not bear fruit so I can grow in faith and love. Help me to stay connected to you in every part of my life. Without you, I can do nothing. Amen.	8 <i>Matthew 13:18-23</i> Lord, prepare my heart to receive your Word with understanding and joy. Help me to be like good soil—bearing fruit through perseverance and faith. Guard me from distractions, fear, or doubt that choke our your truth. Let my life produce a harvest for your glory. Don’t let me turn away from those in need, but move me with compassion and generosity. Teach me that true faith is expressed through love and service. Let my works bring honor to you. Amen.
12 <i>Romans 8:18-28</i> Father, thank you for the promise that our present sufferings are not worth comparing to the glory that is coming. In every trial, remind me that you are working all things together for good. Help me to wait patiently and trust fully in your plan. Strengthen my hope in you. Amen.	13 <i>Psalms 96:1-11</i> Lord, I sing a new song to you, for you are great and greatly to be praised. All creation declares your majesty, and I join in worship. Let my life reflect your glory and my words proclaim your salvation. You reign with justice and truth. Amen.	14 <i>Matthew 8:23-27</i> Jesus, when storms rise and fear creeps in, remind me that you are in the boat with me. Speak peace over the chaos, and grow my faith to trust even when you seem silent. You command the winds and waves—nothing is too powerful for you. I place my fears in your hands. Amen.	15 <i>Psalms 34:15-22</i> Lord, thank you for being close to the brokenhearted and attentive to my cries. You redeem my life and rescue me from despair. Even in trouble, I will trust that you are good and faithful. Keep me walking in righteousness and peace. Amen.	16 <i>Ruth 2:8-12</i> Gracious God, thank you for the way you provide through unexpected kindness. Let me be aware of the needs around me and generous with what I’ve been given. Like Ruth, may I take refuge under your wings and trust in your provision. Bless the work of my hands and heart. Amen.	17 <i>Luke 9:57-62</i> Jesus, following you requires my full surrender. Help me not to look back or be distracted by the things of this world. Give me courage to walk forward in obedience, trusting that your way is better. Make my heart steadfast and my purpose clear. Amen.	18 <i>Psalms 42:1-11</i> Lord, my soul longs for you as the deer pants for water. In moments of despair, remind me to hope in you again. Even when tears fall, I will praise you for your faithfulness. You are my help and my God. Amen.

Give me boldness like David to step forward in faith, armed not with fear but with trust in your power. Let my victories point others to your greatness. I fight not alone, but with you by my side. Let me move forward in faith, knowing you go before me in power. You are my defender and guide. Amen.	28 <i>Psalms 119:18-20</i> Open my eyes, Lord, to see the wonders in your Word. Stir a deep longing in me to know your truth. Let your commandments shape my thoughts and direct my path. May I seek you with all my heart. Amen.	29 <i>Jeremiah 29:10-13</i> Faithful Father, thank you for the plans you have for me—plans for hope and a future. When I seek you with all my heart, I know you will be found. Help me to wait with expectation and pray with confidence. I trust that you are always working for my good. Amen.	30 <i>Matthew 14:25-31</i> Jesus, when I’m afraid and sinking, remind me to reach for your hand. Call me out in faith, and give me courage to walk toward you. Calm my doubts and strengthen my trust. Thank you for never letting me go. Amen.	31 <i>Romans 5:1-5</i> Lord, thank you for the peace I have through faith in Jesus.
