Let my life reflect your love so others are drawn to you. May I not hide the faith you've given me, but boldly live it out. Be glorified in the way I walk, speak, and serve. Amen.

Amen.	27 Proverbs 8:1-11 Lord, your wisdom calls out to me—pure, right, and more valuable than gold. Help me to seek it with all my heart and treasure your truth above all else. May I walk in discernment and not be swayed by the world's empty promises. Lead me by your voice. Amen.
28 Psalm 86:1-7 God, hear my prayer, for I am in need of you. You are gracious and full of mercy, and I place my trust in you alone. In the day of my trouble, I call to you, knowing you will answer. Strengthen my soul and guide me in your truth. Amen.	29 Philippians 4:4-9 Lord, I choose to rejoice in you today. Help me not to be anxious, but to bring every concern to you in prayer. Guard my heart and mind with your peace that surpasses understanding. Let my thoughts dwell on what is true, pure, and praiseworthy. Amen.
