THE CORRUPT CHURCH Thyatira MEANING: Continual Sacrifice	Trade guilds and Jezebel-like immorality
THE DEAD CHURCH Sardis L MEANING: Remnant	Reputation of life, but spiritually dead
THE FAITHFUL CHURCH Philadelphia L MEANING: Brotherly Love	Small but steadfast church
THE LUKEWARM CHURCH Laodicea L MEANING: Rule of the People	Wealthy but spiritually blind and poor

A PRAISE for what is good

A PROBLEM that must be confronted

CHURCH	PORTRAIT	PRAISE
Ephesus	Holds seven stars, walks among lampstands	Works, labor, patience, tested false apostles
Smyrna	First & Last, who was dead & came to life	Faithful through tribulation & poverty (spiritually rich)
Pergamos	Has sharp two-edged sword	Held fast to Christ's name
Thyatira	Son of God; eyes like fire, feet like brass	Works, love, service, faith, patience (last works greater than first)
Sardis	Has seven Spirits of God & seven stars	A few undefiled garments
Philadelphia	Holy & true; holds key of David	Kept word, did not deny Christ, endured patiently
Laodicea	Faithful & true Witness; Beginning of creation	None

EVERY LETTER FOLLOWS THE SAME FRAMEWORK

Left first love	Remember, repent, do first works	Eat from Tree of Life (2:7)

False doctrine (Balaam, Nicolaitans)	Repent or face Christ's sword	Hidden manna; white stone with new name (2:17)
Tolerated Jezebel; immorality, idolatry	Repent; hold fast until Christ comes	Authority over nations; morning star (2:26-28)
Reputation alive, but dead	Be watchful; strengthen; remember; repent	White garments; name not blotted out; confessed before Father (3:5)
None	Hold fast what you have	Pillar in God's temple; God's name; Christ's new name (3:12)
