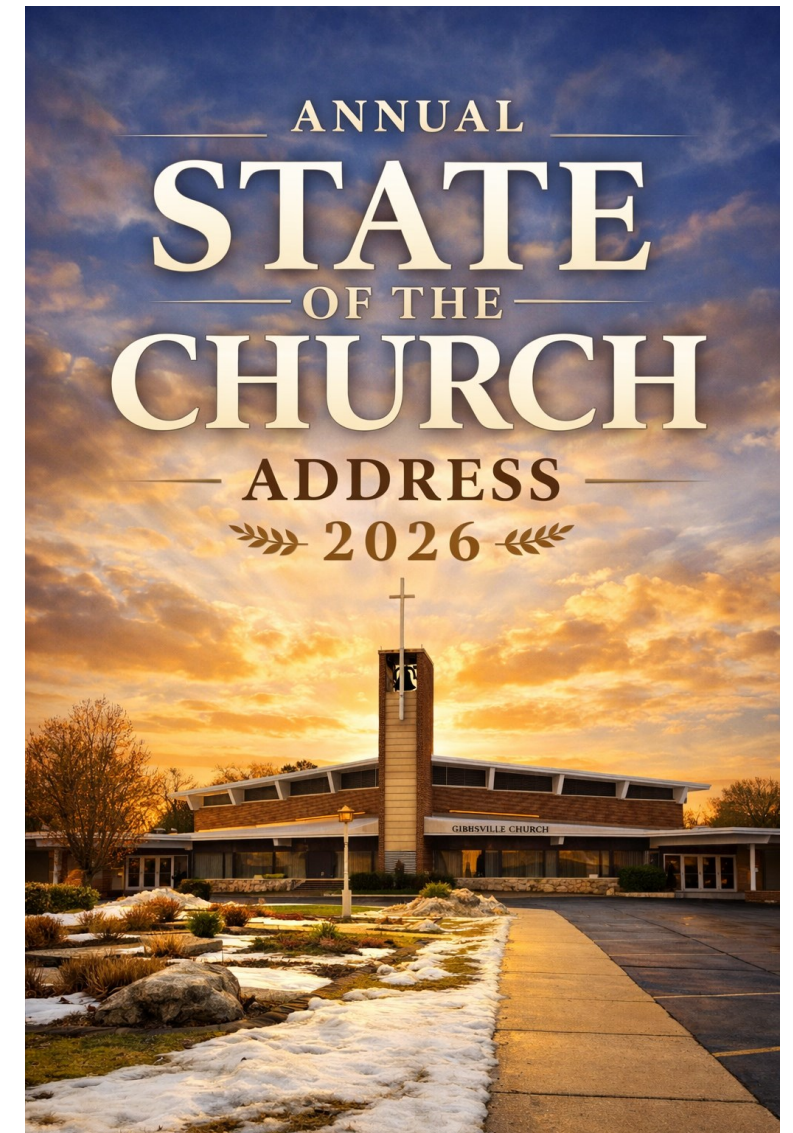

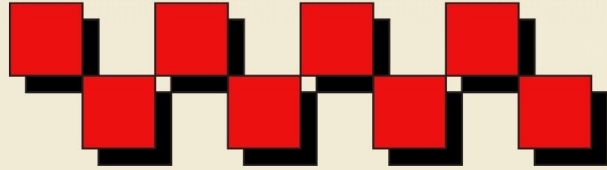

How God Calls Us to Handle Conflict in 2026

— (Matthew 18:15–17) —

1. Avoid the Small Stuff

- Overlook minor offenses when possible
- Choose grace over irritation
- Do not escalate unnecessary conflict

"Love covers a multitude of sins." (1 Peter 4:8)

2. Go Just Between the Two of You

- Speak directly and privately
- Be humble, honest, and loving
- Seek restoration, not winning

*"If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault,
between you and him alone."*

3. Bring One or Two Others Along

- Seek wise, godly counsel
- Confirm facts and motives
- Protect truth and peace

"Every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses."

4. Tell the Elders

- Involve church leadership when repentance is refused
- Trust God's ordained shepherds
- Protect the peace and purity of the church

"If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church."

Goal is peace, unity, restoration, and God's Glory
