Missions On The Move

We are nearing the *LAST CALL* to sign up for our church-wide mission trip to Floyd County, KY, from October 25-31. We will be working alongside of St. Vincent’s Mission, a community of people in Appalachia dedicated to sharing the hope of Christian values. In 2023 alone, a total of 231 volunteers provided 7,632 hours of service, repairing 42 homes in Floyd County. Here are some statistics on how Floyd County compares to our area, as well as the United States as a whole.

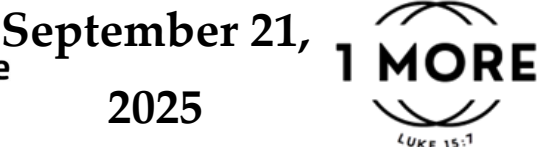
