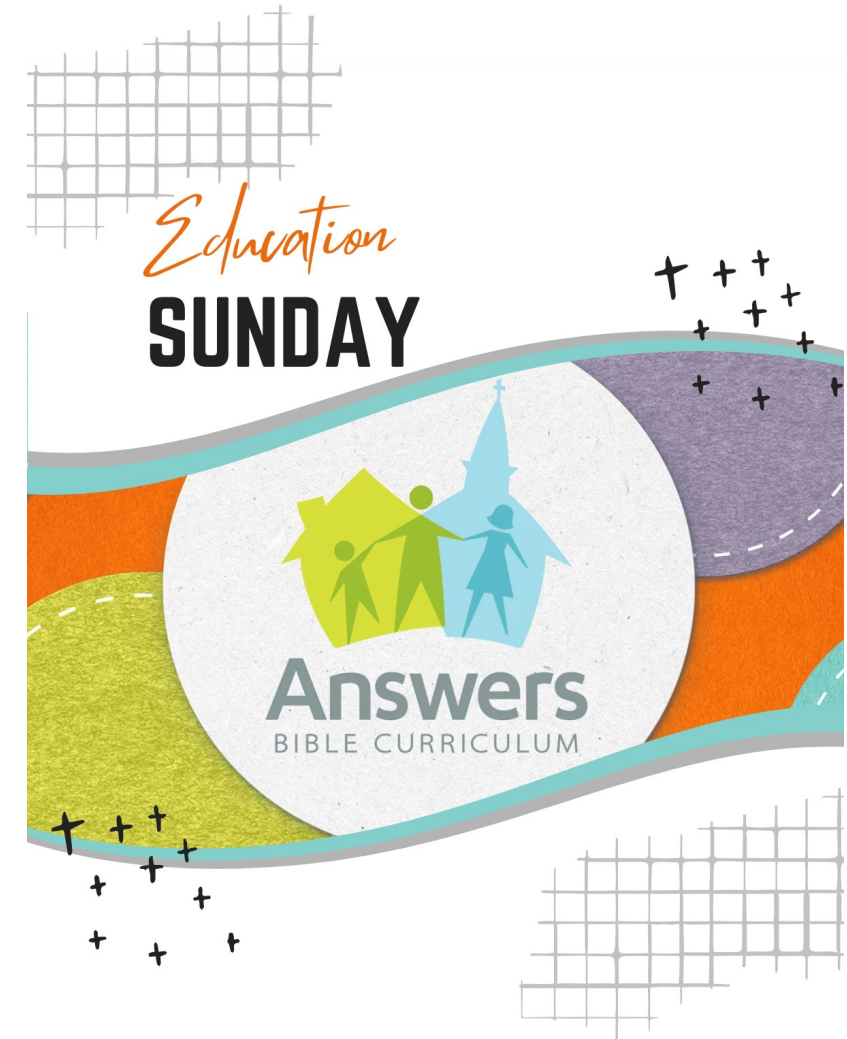


### Sunday School Snacks
