James 4:1-3 (AMP) 1. Selfishness

'What leads to [the unending] quarrels and conflicts among you? Do they not come from your [hedonistic] desires that wage war in your [bodily] members [fighting for control over you]? You are jealous and covet [what others have] and your lust goes unfulfilled; so you murder. You are envious and cannot obtain [the object of your envy]; so you fight and battle. You do not have because you do not ask [it of God]. [1John 3:15] You ask [God for something] and do not receive it, because you ask with wrong motives [out of selfishness or with an unrighteous agenda], so that [when you get what you want] you may spend it on your [hedonistic] desires. '

'For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind. '



2. Resentment

Resentment says "I won't forgive you"

Exercise foresight and be on the watch to look [after one another], to see that no one falls back from and fails to secure God's grace (His unmerited favor and spiritual blessing), in order that no root of resentment (rancor, bitterness, or hatred) shoots forth and causes trouble and bitter torment, and the many become contaminated and defiled by it— (Hebrew 12:15)

The fool who provokes his family to anger and resentment will finally have nothing worthwhile left (Proverbs 11:29)



3. Fear

Fear says "I don't trust you anymore

Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad(Proverbs 12:25)

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. (1 John 4:18)



3.<u>Fear</u>

Fear does three things to relationships:

- -Fear makes me <u>defensive</u>
- -Fear makes me <u>distant</u>
- -Fear makes me <u>demand</u>
