Tax collectors and other notorious sinners often came to listen to Jesus teach. This made the Pharisees and teachers of religious law complain that he was associating with such sinful people— even eating with them! So Jesus told them this story...

—Luke 15:1-3 (NLT)

What Does God Do When Someone's Lost?

1. He Sends Out A Search Party.

- *If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders.*

—Luke 15:4-5 (NLT)

- *I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd sacrifices his life for the sheep.*

—John 10:11 (NLT)

2. He Searches Desperately.

- *Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Won't she light a lamp and sweep the entire house and search carefully until she finds it?*

—Luke 15:8 (NLT)

- *So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.*

—Genesis 1:27 (NLT)

3. He Throws A Huge Party.

- *When he arrives, he will call together his friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.' In the same way, there is more joy in heaven over one lost sinner who*

repents and returns to God than over ninety-nine others who are righteous and haven't strayed away!

—Luke 15:6-7 (NLT)

- *And when she finds it, she will call in her friends and neighbors and say, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents.*

—Luke 15:9-10 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on where you are right now?

Are you “lost”? If not are you showing that you care desperately about the people that God cares desperately in some way?
